hereafter mentioned And as to what temporal Estate which the Lord
of his Gracious bounty hath been pleased to bestow upon me I give
and bequeath as followeth

First I give and bequeath unto my Wife Ann Morris Wife to
William Morris one Son of half after my Wifes Decease.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Niece Mary House wife to
Anthony House one Cow and Calf after my Wifes decease I likewise
give to my said Niece five Pounds to be paid her out of my Estate
after my Wifes decease

Item I give & bequeath unto my Kinsman William Morris Son of Wm Morris
one Cow and Calf to be paid him after my Wifes decease.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Niece Hannah Tavernor one Cow
and Calf after my Wifes decease.

Item I give and bequeath unto Mary Pond Wife of Daniel Pond a Negro
Man called Will after my Wifes decease.

Further I will that after my Just Debts and Legacies be paid that the
residue of my Estate of what kind quality or Condition soever shall go to
my loving Wife Mary Tavernor to dispose of as she shall think fit and
I do hereby nominate constitute and Appoint my loving Wife Mary
Tavernor whole and sole Executrix of this my last Will & Testament
