1. FRANCIS<sup>1</sup> COLE (Source: VA Wills and Administrations.) died Bef. May 1657. He married ALICE (?) COLE.

Notes for FRANCIS COLE:

Lancaster Co., VA Court Orders 1656 - 1666:

Court 27 May, 1657: Probate of the will of Francys COLE to Alice COLE, he the husband of Alice. Alice the widow in behalf of Mary her dau. making to appear by sufficient testimony that Roger Radford deed did by his nuncupativo will give unto the ad. Mary her dau. his land.

Notes for ALICE (?) COLE:

Lancaster Co., VA Court Orders 1656-1666

Court 26 Jan 1658: George Marsh who married ye relict and Exx. of Francys COLE deed and a division of the Est. ordered.

Court 30 Nov. 1659: George Marsh who married Alice COLE one of the Exors of Francis COLE and Mr. John Edwards in behalf of John Hashwood (Haslewood) who married with Frances COLE one of the daughters of the sd. Francis COLE, the tobacco from England is to be divided between the wife of Mr. Marsh and her two daughters Francys now the wife of John Hashwood and Mary COLE youngest dau. of the sd. Francis COLE.

Notes for JOHN HASLEWOOD:

From the Lancaster County, VA Court records:

Court 10 May 1665: Thomas Chatuyn to be discharged as constable and John Hastewood appointed.

Court 8 Nov. 1665: Certificate to John Hastewood for the transportation of Edward Lasten, William Harbor, Robert White.....

Court 11 April 1666: John Hashwood discharged as Constable and Humphrey Jones appointed.

Indenture 8 July 1669, between Nicholas Spencer of Nominy in Westmoreland Co. Gent. & Francys Mottram ... witnessed by Marmaduke Hashwood & Jacques Romy.

Petition to John Ashley, 137 acres, adjacent to Mr. Robert Griggs and Abya Bonnison and the Glebe lands, 20 Dec. 1669; John Ashley assigns to Robert Briggs, 17 Jun 1671, witnesses Richard Barbor and Henry Hastewood, Recognized 11 Jul 1671.

Petition of John Hastewood (Haslewood), by the will of Franceys COLE decd., father of Franceys wife of John Hastewood, & she decd., and to Mary COLE his sister (to be equally divided), 500 acres.

2. ii. MARY COLE, d. Bet. November 1710 - April 1711.

2. MARY<sup>2</sup> COLE (FRANCIS<sup>1</sup>) (Source: VA Wills and Administrations.) died Bet. November 1710 - April 1711. She married THOMAS HASLEWOOD.

p.198 Transcription of Last Will and Testament of Mary Haslewood, Middlesex County, VA Will Book A (1698-1713), p.6 and Microfilm: Middlesex County, VA Positive Reel #21 Library of VA, Richmond, VA. In the name of God Amen I Mary Haslewood of the County of Middlesex, widdow, being sick in body but of perfect sense and memory thanks and praise be given to almighty God ....

Item - I give and bequeath for my son Thomas Haslewood all that tract or dividend of land whereon I now live together with all my land there unto adjoining and since taken up, to him my said son Thomas Haslewood and to the heirs of his body lawfully begotton forever. And for want of such heirs aforesaid then I give and bequeath the said land to my Grandson, Thomas Catlett and to the heirs of his body lawful begotton forever and for want of such heirs then it is my will and I give and bequeath the said land to my grandson William CATLETT and to the heirs of his body lawful begotto forever.

Item - I give and bequeath unto my said son Thomas Haslewood all my personal estate of what nature and quality forever to him and his heirs or assigns forever.

Item - I give and bequeath unto my said son Thomas Haslewood my Molluto man named Noll to him and his assigns forever.

Item - I give unto my daughter Frances CATLETT twenty shillings to buy her a morning ring withall.

Item - I give and bequeath unto my grandson Humphrey JONES the son of my daughter Jane Jones twenty shillings to buy him a ring withall.

and, lastly, I make ordaine constitute and appoint my dear and well beloved son Thomas Haslewood sole executor of this my last will and testament in witness whereof I have here unto set my hand affixed my seale this 18th day of November, 1710.

3. FRANCES<sup>3</sup> HASLEWOOD (MARY<sup>2</sup> COLE, FRANCIS<sup>1</sup>) was born Abt. 1681. She married THOMAS CATLETT.

Notes for FRANCES HASLEWOOD:

Frances made her last appearance in the court Oct. 11, 1724 when she went to have a slave's age judged. William, their son, was in control of the family property in April, 1728.

Notes for THOMAS CATLETT:

Found in the records in Lancaster County beginning in 1701. The nature of these records imply he was an adult at that time. This would take his birth back to the late 1670s as the latest date for his birth. Of course he could have been older. His wife, Frances, was appointed to administer his estate.

Children of FRANCES HASELWOOD and THOMAS CATLETT are:

Notes for WILLIAM CATLETT:

William was the residual heir in his grandmother's will should Thomas her son and Thomas her grandson (William's brother) die.

4. JANE<sup>3</sup> HASELWOOD (*MARY<sup>2</sup> COLE, FRANCIS<sup>1</sup>*) was born Abt. 1683. She married HUMPHREY JONES (Source: VA Wills and Administrations.) February 18, 1703/04 in Christ Church, Middlesex Co., VA.
