ELEY'S of AMERICA

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The earliest reference of the Eley name is that of one Robert Eley who probably came over in the ship Primrose which sailed from Gravesend, England for the Virginia Colony on July 27, 1635. He is listed in Hotten's Emigrants ROBERT ELEY I, b. c. 1621, England, probably came over in Primrose which sailed from Gravesend, England for Virginia July 27, 1635.

Hotten Emigrants, p. 115, see Ely shown as Crelie, ae. 14. P. 529 lists Robert Eelie.

17th Century Isle of Wight, Va., p. 666 Sept. 17, 1639 Robert Eley Patented 600 acres in Isle of Wight Co., VA.

Isle of Wight Land Grants, p. 670 - On June 25, 1644 Robert Eley assigned to Wm. Trollder 150 acres out of their patent (17th Century Isle of Wight, Va., p. 529). He then probably moved to Nansemond where the records were destroyed.

Josiah Eley was a Revolutionary Soldier, and the following story is contained in the records of a descendant James Henry Eley of Union Springs, Ala.

"Josiah was on furlough at home. A Tory went in his home to get him. He escaped, but shot the Tory when the Tory slapped his wife, Charity Denby."

State of Alabama, Macon County, made the 24th day of June 1842.

To my beloved wife, Martha, the « of the Plantation whereon I now live, with half of the dwelling and other houses together with all the household and kitchen furniture, all the stock, houses, cattle, hogs, sheep, etc., etc. Also twelve negroes, namely, Peter, Aaron, Isaac, Henry, Mary, Ann, Squire, Melvena, Harriet, Elisha, William and Henry, during her natural life and at her death all the above named property (land excepted with the increase and all the other property not herein mentioned to be sold and divided equally between my six children Josiah J. Eley, John W.

Eley, Priscella N. Tarver, Martha H. Colquitt, Eliza W. Rogers, and Micajah N. Eley. I do also give and bequeath to my wife all the money in my possession at my death.

I give and bequeath to my son, Micajah N. Eley, in Trust for his wife and children, the other half of my Plantation whereon I now live, also the following negroes, viz. Tempy, Archer, Sarah, Polly

dove, Delia, Jim Foster, Juda, Mary Jane, Lonan, Davy and little Harriett; one bed, bedstead and furniture, two cows and calves and two sows and pigs.

The land not to be divided until the death of my wife, Martha.

I give and bequeath unto my granddaughter Susannah Jackson five hundred dollars to be paid by my executors and to Martha Terry I give five hundred dollars to be kept in the hands of said executors for her benefit.

I do appoint my wife Martha and my sons Josiah James and Micajah N. Eley, my executors to this my last will and testament.
