

# THE PERKINS FAMILY of VIRGINIA

DESCENDANTS OF NICHOLAS PERKINS WHO DIED CA. 1654 IN CHARLES CITY COUNTY

Attempts have been made to connect the Virginia Perkins family with various Perkins families in England, especially with the one of Upton in Berkshire. There was a Nicholas Perkins whose birth in 1572 is listed in the Register of Christ Church, Newgate, London. Another Nicholas Perkins married Jane Iremonger in 1613 in Bedfordshire. Actually there is no evidence known which links Nicholas Perkins of Virginia to any Perkins family in England. The only known facts (shown by Virginia records) are these:

Nicholas Perkins came to Virginia in 1641; was granted 170 acres in Bermuda Hundred, Henrico County, in 1650; died about 1654 in Charles City county leaving a widow Mary (who subsequently married Dr. Richard Parker) and children Lydia, Sarah, Elizabeth, Nicholas, (who are mentioned in Charles City Co. records) and possibly others. Dr. Parker and wife and three of the Perkins children moved to Henrico County.

The following outline is a brief one without references and showing only the male descent. It is anticipated that this preliminary report will be followed at some later date, with a complete record of all descendants etc. More complete records on several thousand descendants are now contained in the records of Wm. K. Hall (q.v.)

The numbering system used here indicates lines of descent = the children of 431 are numbered 4311, 4312, 4313, etc. Similarly 4624 was the son of 462 and the grandson of 46. The following abbreviations are used: b. = born, o. or ca. = about, d. = died, m. = married, w. = will, b.w. = both wills, L = lived, d.s.p. = died without issue, unm. = unmarried. The question mark (?) following data means that such is believed, or has been so stated, but has not been proved. All locations are in Virginia, unless otherwise stated. The plus sign (+) preceding the number of the descendant means that this family had issue, and that these children are listed in the proper place under the next generation. The dates in parentheses following the names, are first, the date of birth, second, date of death.
