- > Does anyone know where the Indian River is? Was he a son of George Stegall,
- > Jr.?

Where did you find the info about Richard being born on the Indian River?? I don't believe he was a son of George Stegall. There seems to be a lot of information about George Sr. and George Jr. but there is nothing to tie a Richard to a George -- at least not that I have seen.

I have land transactions by Richard in Montgomery Co. VA that refer to Indian Ridge, Burks Ford, Greasy Creek, and New River. I have never tried to locate where the land was located, but my 1854 Gazeter gives the following info. Floyd Co. VA has a Greasy Creek Post Office. Montgomery Co. VA (and several adjacent counties) refer to a New River that is also known as Kawawha River.

When Richard was involved in Montgomery Co., the county was much larger than it is now, and included areas that are now in western VA and eastern West VA. And the New River / Kawawha River seems to flow from VA into W VA.
