

BLACKSTOCK

William Blackstock, b. ca 1720 Belfast, County Antrim, Ireland, believed to be son of Thomas Blackstock, b. ca 1670 in above place who brought his family to S. C. and had sons, Harry Blackstock, b. 1698 in Belfast, Ire., and the sd William Berry Blackstock.

William Berry Blackstock was m. to Mary Irwin, b. 1721 Pa., d. 1777 Union Co., S. C., and bur. on the Blackstock plantation. William was listed on 1790 Spartanburg Co. S. C. Census, his LWT dtd Union Co. S. C. 9/19/1788, pvd 1/2/1799, filed Box 2, Pack. 51. He names his wife, Euphemy, and children: Mary Beard, William Blackstock and Ruth Blackstock. Issue:

I. William Blackstock, his LWT dtd 2/17/1841 Spartanburg Co., S. C., m. Mary Yarborough. William was b. ca 1750 and had four daus and one son who died without issue.

Stub Entries to Indents for Revolutionary Claims, Part 2, by Salley:
"Page 56. No. 2724, Book X, Issued 10th May 1786 for Mr. William Blackstock for the sum of 17.1=1/2 Sterling duty-Brandons Regiment..."

Holcombe-Nation Builders by Mrs. L. D. Weir McPherson, P. 453:

"Mary Blackstock, married 1820 Berry Langston [born 1792-died 9/10/1847] born 8/4/1801, died 11/17/1874, daughter of William Blackstock, II, Revolutionary Soldier, Irish Presbyterian, immigrant from County Antrim, Ireland to Pennsylvania. The Revolutionary Battle of Blackstock was fought on his farm November 20, 1780 on the southside of Tyger River in Spartanburg district, South Carolina, 60 miles from Winnsboro and 35 miles from Fish Dam Ford on Broad River. He lived to be nearly one hundred years. Died 1841."

Issue of William Blackstock: Polly who m. Berry Poole; Jane who m. Mr. Foster; and Mary, b. 8/4/1801, d. 11/17/1874, m. Berry Langston.

II. John Blackstock, his LWT pvd Abbeville District, S. C., 9/17/1785, naming bro., James. Formerly from Laurens Co., S. C. Wife, Neomy. The inv. of his est. given by Solomon Langston, Thomas Murphy and Jesse Holder. Solomon removed to Ga. and is believed to be related to Samuel Langston, whose dau., Mary, m. Kendred Blackstock Oct. 4, 1820 in Jackson Co., Ga. Solomon also appeared on 1800 Laurens Co. S. C. Census.

Stub Entries to Indents from Revolutionary Claims, by Salley, Book I, P. 108: "No. 612, Book I, Issued 3rd January 1785 to Mr. John Blackstock for 3 pds. Sterling for Militia duty as a Private Horseman, Captain John Irvins payroll and account audited. Principle #3.O.O. Interest O.4.2."

Issue of John Blackstock as follows: William Blackstock.

III. Margaret Blackstock m. William Beard, who served in the Rev. War, part of Irvin's Brigade. Margaret died 1835/1837 Pendleton District, S. C. She had only one son, who went to Ga., and her dau. to Tennessee.

IV. Mary Ann Blackstock m. Robert Beard, left for Georgia in 1815 or 1816 and had all girls.

V. Thomas Blackstock, b. ca 1753, m. 5/10/1771 Charlotte Co., Va., Miss Sinah Sullivan.

VI. Richard Blackstock, b. ca 1754. Wife, Sally. According to his gr-son, Nehemiah, in various letters written in 1873, Richard Blackstock was illegitimate, born July of 1774, d. 4/26/1830 in Hall Co., Ga. Issue of Richard, Sr.:

Greenville Co., S. C. DB D, P. 470, dtd 1/16/1798, James Blackstock to William Percythe, Indenture dtd 2/4/1777, for fifteen pds, lands on waters of Grove Creek, 100 acres. Hall Co. Ga. DB B, P. 423, "Georgia, DeKalb County," dtd 6/19/1828, James Blackstock, Sr. to James Blackstock, Jr. for \$350, 578 acres on Allens Fork, Oconee River,

in Hall Co., Ga., also 578 acres. DeKalb Co., Ga. Inf. Ct. Mts., 1823-1859, P. 3, James Blackstock apptd Commissioner for the 14th district, formerly Henry Co., for the poor school trust. He was apptd Justice of Inf. Court 1824, and a Commissioner of Roads. The last record found of him in DeKalb Co., was a lawsuit, Daniel Stone, Adm. vs. James Blackstock, Debt of \$175.00, July 12, 1830.

Greenville Co. S. C. DBC, P. 305-7, 1/13/1793, James Blackstock of Greenville Co. to John Hinson, 119 acres. Jackson Co., Ga. DB IJ, P. 14, 2/11/1815, Joseph Davis, Exr. of John Wright, decd, to James Blackstock, both of Jackson Co., land on Allens Fork of Oconee River, 458 acres. Hall Co. deed 9/3/1820, William Dison to James Blackstock, 27 acres on waters of Walnut Fork of Oconee River.

4. James Blackstock, Jr., b. 5/2/1789, d. 4/13/1852 Cobb Co. Ga. He was Commander of DeKalb Co. Academy in 1823, 2d Lt. in Forsyth Co. Mil. 1837. Listed on 1850 Henry Co. Ga. Census. Wife, K. B., b. 1814. Issue as follows: J. L., son, b. 1834; A. C., dau., b. 1837; J. W., son, b. 1839; A. C., dau., b. 1842; and R. T., son, b. 1844, all Henry Co. Ga. First Hundred Years in Cobb County by Sarah Blackwell Gober Temple, P. 53, the following notation establishes another son:

"Wilson Blackstock was from DeKalb. He seems to have drawn land in Cobb County himself by James F. Blackstock, Jr., of Heard's District, DeKalb County, listed as a soldier, drew land in the 20th District, 23rd Section. This family must have come from the upper country down to DeKalb. M. Blackstock drew in Hall County and much is found of the name in Jackson County."

Wilson F. Blackstock, b. 1812 Ga., Miller, w., Sarah, b. 1812, listed on 1850 Campbell Co. Ga. Census. He m. Sarah Umphrey 5/10/1832, in Fayette Co., Ga. and had: John J., b. 1833; Mary Ann, b. 1835; Jan N., b. 1839; Moses, b. 1841; Susan, b. 1841; Sarah, b. 1845; Wilson, b. 1847;

and William, b. 1850. All b. Henry Co., except last son, William, who was b. Campbell Co., Ga.

5. Daniel Blackstock, b. 1795 Greenville Co., S. C., Lt., Jackson Co. Ga. Mil. 1818 to 1820, Capt. in Hall Co. Mil. 1823-1833. Listed on 1820-60 Hall Co., Ga. Census. Daniel m. Martha Wright, b. 1799 Ga., on 7/9/1815 Jackson Co., Ga. Hall Co. Mts and Ests, Bk 2, 1849-1864, P. 498, "F. M. Blackstock and Martha Blackstock, January Term of 1863." P. 543 is the citation to sell real estate by Mrs. Martha Blackstock. The 1864 Ann. Ret., filed in Misc. H., P. 530-539, "In Account with Martha Blackstock, admx. of Estate of Daniel Blackstock, paid Jasper Blackstock, \$1330.00; William Blackstock \$925.00; and Martha Blackstock, \$1600.00 for support. Issue of Daniel Blackstock, as follows:

C., m. 10/4/1820, Mary Langston, in Jackson Co., Ga., m. 2d Elizabeth Cook, 12/3/1829 Fayette Co., Ga., a dau. of Harbard Cook who d. 6/1854 in Fayette Co., date of his LWT and his w., Elizabeth, the gr-dau of John Cook of first Jefferson, then Fayette Co., Ga., b. 1761 in Pa. and his w., Milley, b. 1766 Va., listed on 1850 Fayette Co., Ga. Census. His first w., Mary Langston, was dau. of Samuel Langston, whose LWT is dtd 10/6/1825 Jackson Co., Ga. WB A, P. 110, in which he names his dau., Mary Blackstock. Mary apparently was decd by 1828 or 1829.

Jackson Co. DB H, P. 430, William Ray to Kendred Blackstock of DeKalb Co. and Ailsey Wright of Jackson Co. Ga., the legal heirs of Samuel Langston, late of Jackson Co. and Washington Chamble of Gwinnett Co., for \$1200, grants 250 acres of Jackson Co. land July 17, 1827.

Jackson Co. DB I & J, P. 281, 7/17/1827, Mary Wright of Jackson Co., William Wray of Henry Co., John Williamson of Gwinnett Co., Kendred Blackstock of DeKalb Co., legatees of Samuel Langston, late of sd county, and the heirs general of Richard Blackstock, late of the county, for \$300, grants land in Jackson Co. on n.s. of mulberry fork of Oconee River, 75 acres.
