## **New Additions by Jeannette Holland Austin**

The long search for the parents of Peyton Clements of Granville County, North Carolina found him there as early as 1764 but no further evidence in North Carolina or other States. The closest suspect is Benjamin Clements (1700-1780) of "Clement Hill" in Pittsylvania County, but his will did not name Peyton. \*When researching Granville County families, one also researches Pittsylvania County because the same families resided in both counties.

Turner H. Clements, a son of David Clements, was born 1817 in Putnam County, Georgia. Turner was a resident of McDonough in Henry County, 1880 Census. He stated that his parents were born in Virginia. This could easily be (see above comment)\* Turner must have married again, because his wife was Ellen, age 57.
