

CRAWFORD

Charles Crawford, b. 1738 Hanover Co., Va., son of David and Ann (Anderson) Crawford, make petition for land grant March 1772 of 250 acres in Ga., declaring he had been a resident of Ga. "for some time". In said petition, he stated he had a wife, four children and five slaves, and wished to establish a homesite on branches of Uchee Creek, in St. Paul's Parish, Richmond Co., Ga. Before the American Revolution, he owned 800 acres of land, was Justice of Peace of his militia district, and elected as member of the Ga. General Assembly from Richmond Co., which he served until 1785. In 1779 he was apptd a Commissioner of Claims for Confiscated Property in Richmond Co., and during the war served as Capt. under the command of Lt. Col. Robert Middleton. He served as a member of the State Legislature beginning 1782, and in 1783 was apptd Commissioner of Indian Affairs for Ga. After the war, he received many land grants, in Columbia and Washington Counties.

Charles Crawford m. Jane Maxwell in Hanover Co., Va. ca 1762, to whom he left his plantation on Dyar's Creek, etc. His LWT dtd 9/27/1811 Columbia Co., Ga., named children, as well as grandson, Joel Barnett, son of his decd dau., Elizabeth, formerly wife of Joel Barnett, Sr., whom she married in 1787. b. George W. Crawford, b. 1799 Columbia Co., Ga, w., Elizabeth, b. 1808 Ga. His LWT dtd 5/8/1884, pvd 5/8/1884 Columbia Co., Ga. George fought a dual with Thomas Burnside of Columbia Co. at Ft. Mitchell, across the Chattahoochee River, and Burnside was killed on third charge. In the LWT of Thomas Burnside dtd 1/14/1828, pvd 4/21/1828 Columbia Co., he said: "Being about to have a contest of a sanguinary nature, with a man with whom I have never sought a quarrel of any sort..." Issue of George W. Crawford: William P., b. 1833; Sarah, b. 1835; and Anna E., b. 1837, all Richmond Co., Ga.

4. Simmons Crawford, b. 1798 Columbia Co., Ga., d. 1878 Columbia Co., Ga. m. Pamela Moore 2/4/1819 Columbia Co., who was decd in 1842. The LWT of Patsy Moore dtd 9/1/1842, pvd 3/10/1852 Columbia Co. names as heir her grandson, Anderson Moore Crawford (m. Mary Cassandra Collins, Columbia Co.), son of Simmons Crawford, and decd dau., Pamela. Issue of Simmons Crawford follows:

a. Anderson Crawford, b. 11/13/1820 Columbia Co., Ga., d. 1906 Columbia Co. Known as "Cuff" Crawford., m. 1st Elizabeth Williams, having no issue, 2d Mary Collins, had four children, and 3rd to Antonia Lamar Moore and had ten children, one of whom was Basil Lamar Crawford b. 7/12/1867, d. 10/30/1950 m. 1/21/1891 Belle Virginia Crawford, a cousin; she d. 11/2/1952 and had James Louis, b. in Columbia Co., Ga., m. in Tulsa, Okla., Mollie Leila Petty.

5. Robert Crawford m. a dau. of David Maxwell, His LWT dtd 12/26/1800, pvd 12/3/1801 Columbia Co., Ga. naming heir, son-in-law, Robert Crawford and Elizabeth Jane Bulloch, dau. of Daniel Bulloch, exr, Peter Crawford.

III. Nathan Crawford, b. Va., physician, his LWT dtd 3/26/1860, pvd 11/1861 Columbia Co., Ga. m. Mary Marshall, dau. of Levi Marshall and Sarah Wynne. Levi Marshall was son of Daniel Marshall, b. 1706 in Windsor, Conn. The LWT of Levi Marshall dtd 8/11/1807, pvd 9/8/1807 Columbia Co., Ga., names Polly Crawford and son-in-law, Nathan Crawford. Issue of Nathan follows:
