Michael Dickson, Sr., of Lunenburg Co., Va., Caswell Co., N. C., and Hancock Co., Ga., came to Lunenburg Co. with his kinsman, Josiah Dickson in 1740 where they purchased land. Within a year, Michael m. Mary Dickson (decd by 1763), the dau. of Thomas Dickson (1690-1763), who migrated from Prince Geo. Co., Va. into Lunenburg Co. by 9/4/1746. Thomas Dickson had purchased 335 acres on Lunenburg-Brunswick Co. line. When Thomas settled in Lunenburg, his family was wife, Mary and issue: Benjamin, Sarah, Mary and Elizabeth, and later another dau., Ann, was born. His LWT dtd 1763 confirmed that his dau., Sarah, m. William Redmon.

Early in 1751 Michael and Josiah disposed of their lands and went to Granville Co., N. C., Michael settling in what later became Orange, finally Caswell Co. (later Person Co.) N. C. In 1779, Michael, Sr., deeded land to each of his sons, Michael, Jr. and Josiah. Michael, Sr., died 1796 Person Co., N. C., with son, Josiah, admr. of his estate.

Bk 2, P. 359-361, Lunenburg Co., Michael Dickson purchased 400 acres from William Redmon 7/1748 on lower side of Little Roanoke River. Order Bk I, P. 79, 10/1748, Thomas Dickson to Michael Dickson, deed party proved between Thomas and Michael, with memorandum of Livery and seizen therein endorsed. Thomas Dickson conveyed 382 acres of his 536 acre grant to his "son-in-law", Michael Dickson, in 1748. Michael was living on the land when it was sold to Nathaniel Terry in 1750. He turned over to his bro-in-law, Benjamin Dickson, some uncollected debts. Issue of Michael, Sr. follows:

Michael, Jr. received a land grant of 100 acres 1793 Effingham Co., Ga.; also in 1786, 200 acres. In 1793, he recd 560 acres in Washington Co.; in 1789, 575 acres, in 1790, 337 acres, and in 1800, 876 acres. His LWT dd 8/27/1803 Hancock Co., Ga. names w., Martha. He is bur. in town cemetery at Sparta, Ga., bur. next to him is Lucy Dickson, d. 1849, aged 56 years. In his application for land grant in Washington Co., Ga. and 4/5/1784, he stated he was already a citizen of Ga. from which he was granted 450 acres in Washington Co. DB A, P. 209, Lunenburg Co., va., 6/21/1779, Michael Dickson, Sr. to Michael Dickson, Jr. of same co., Nash Dist., 281 acres, both sides Adams Creek in Caswell Co., N. C. Issue of Michael, Jr. follows:
