

FLEMING

Porter Fleming, of Scotch-Irish descent, b. 8/29/1808 Lincoln Co., Ga., was son of Robert Fleming from Va., m. 1st Martha Fleming 6/20/1835, Richmond Co., Ga., 2d, Catherine B. Moragne from Abbeville, S. C., of Huguenot origin. Issue: William H., attorney, lived at Augusta, Ga., d. 10/18/1856; Frank E., Augusta banker, b. 1/12/1854, m. 1891, Miss Julia Twiggs; John M.; William H.; Catherine L.; Minnie C.; Lamar L.; C. Moragne; and Porter, Jr.

James L. Fleming, b. 8/12/1843 Lincoln Co., Ga., was orphaned at the age of 7; his uncle was Porter Fleming.

John S. Fleming, b. 1817 Ga., cotton buyer, wife, Laura E., b. 1827, lived in Richmond Co., Ga. in 1850, and had son, William R. Fleming, d. 1848 Richmond Co. Ga.

The Southern Recorder 2/7/1829: "Died in Louisville, Tuesday morning the 18th ult., Miss Mary Matilda Fleming, orphan daughter of Robert Fleming, in her 12th year."

The Columbian Museum & Savannah Daily Gazette, 10/16/1817: "Died on 13th inst., Mrs. Mary Fleming, relict of Mr. Thomas Fleming, age 90 yrs. She was a native of S. C. Her parents fled France on the Edict of Nantes... She was for many years a respectable citizen of Savannah."

Porter Fleming died 9/9/1891 in Augusta, Georgia. His father, Robert Fleming, was born 8/12/1777 and was from North Carolina.
