William Henry b. ca 1760, d. 1840, m. Jane Russell, b. 1770, dau. of Alexander and Jane Russell from Orange Co., N. C., who removed to Gwinnett Co. Ga. abt 1820, bur. in family cemetery, called Sodom Churchyard, on old homelace. Issue:

Rebecca Brooks Lee was b. 1790 Ga., living with above family in 1850.

VI. Joseph Tanner Henry, b. 1802 S. C., m. Clary Minor, dau. of Lazarus and Mary Jones Minor. Issue: Cyrus Henry; Missouri Henry m. Mr. Orr; Emma Henry m. Mr. Rrkle; Arthusa Henry m. 1st Mr. Tuggle, 2nd, Mr. Owens; Zipporah Jane Henry m. John Riley Hopkins, Flavius Henry, d. battle of Vicksburg; and Patrick Henry, d. during civil war.

VIII. James Russell Henry, b. 6/17/1810 S. C., d. 10/21/1865 Madore, Ill., m. 10/1/1839 Permelia Frances Eckles, d. 6/14/1903, dau. of Robert B. and Eliza Griffin Paxson Eckles. While in civil war, he was taken prisoner by yankees, later released. Lived Atlanta, Ga., but w. is bur. Jackson Co. Ga., near Commerce, at Harmony Christian Church. Issue:
