James Jackson, Sr., Will dtd 2/9/1761, pvd 9/1761 Halifax Co., N. C. exrs, sons, Thomas, James and William Jackson. To children: Thomas, "money I lent him to pay for his land"; to James, money; to John, "land I took up joining John Mustion." To Ann Henderson "money when recovered of Turner Jackson in Charles City Co., Va.; to Lucy Gylum; Elizabeth Richard; Jacob Jackson. W., Ann.

Thomas Jackson, his Will dtd 1/8/1777, pvd 5/1784 Halifax Co., N. C., names w., Mary, bro., William and issue: Edward, Sarah and Judy. John Jackson went to Edgefield Co., S. C., and William Jackson's Will is dated 6/21/1805, pvd 8/1805, Halifax Co. N. C. naming William, Matthew, Elizabeth, Fanny Pearman.

John Jackson of Edgefield Co. S. C., Will dtd 2/26/1787, pvd 1794, names: Henry Jackson, Drewry Jackson, Abigail Duncomb, James Jackson, Alsey Kimbrall, Ann Miller, John Jackson, Jr. and Greene Jackson. 8/4/1778, Richmond Co., John Jackson witd a deed of Ignatius Few to Charles Burk for 300 acres on Uptons Creek. His son, John, aged 90, m. Mrs. Ellender Kirkland, aged 85, 2/28/1854, Edgefield Co. S. C.

Drury ["Drewry"] Jackson, b. 1745, m. 1768 Nancy Mayfield, b. 1749, d. 11/18/1837, according to McCall's Roster of the Revolution. Drury Jackson and Abraham Mayfield are found in Warren Co. N. C. 1790. 1784 certificate of Col. Elijah Clarke to Drury Jackson certifying that he was in Ga. Troops. Wilkes Co. Ga. III, P. 123 McCall's Roster of the Revolution, "Daniel Jackson was born 1735 in South Carolina, died 1812 Wilkes Co., Ga. Private under Colonel John Brandon in South Carolina. Married 1770 Nancy High." Clarke Co., Ga., BK B, Admrs & Gdns Bonds, list decedent, Daniel Jackson, with Samuel Jackson and John Jackson, admrs, 12/5/1814. Issue according to above reference: Samuel, 1786-1830 m. Orrie Cox; Elizabeth, 1792-1872 m. Jack Wilburn, s. of Thomas Wilburn, Rev. War Soldier and his w., Martha.

Samuel Jackson, his son, from 1809-1811, Sheriff of Clarke Co.; listed 1820 Clarke Co. Census; 1830 Walton Co. Census. Will dtd 1/1831 Walton Co. Ga. Samuel and John Jackson were sureties of the est. of James W. Darby, Clarke Co., 1821. John Jackson also taking part in est. of Jeremiah Brown, along with Jesse Cox, Jasper Co., 1821. Samuel Jackson m. Orry Cox, dau. of Jesse and Sarah Cox of Jasper Co., per Will of Jesse Cox dtd 9/7/1824 Jasper Co. There are numerous deeds in Clarke Co. for Samuel, dating from 1809 to 1824, referred to sometimes as "Colonel Samuel Jackson", also deeds in Jasper and Walton Cos. His Will in Walton Co. WB B, pvd Jan. Term of 1831, names four children: Daniel, Olly, Polly and Jesse "as they arrive at age of twenty one or marry", appointing his brother, John Jackson and John H. Lowe, exrs. Macon Telegraph, 10/16/1827 - "Died in Walton County, Mrs. Orrie Jackson, aged 26 years, consort of Colonel Samuel Jackson." Also, The Augusta Herald, 9/28/1827- "Died, Mrs. Orrie Jackson, Sept. 16th, in Monroe, Walton County, on her birthday, aged 36 years, wife of Colonel Samuel Jackson. Left four children." Invs. of Ests, 1793-4, P. 1, Estate of Daniel Jackson, decd., Inv. dtd 1/10/1794, includes many slaves, cattle, etc. In 1785 he was listed on tax digest, 1-1/2 polls, 1 slave. Estate of Daniel Jackson, decd, Robert Jackson and Jeremiah Reeves apptd exrs. Retns made for 1795 of Daniel Jackson, pd William Jackson 24 pounds, Daniel Karr for tuition, John McDermett for board. Thomas Hammock apptd gdn of John Jackson. Returns of 1797 paid William Jackson, one of legatees. Returns for 1798, receipts of Daniel and Joshua Jackson in part for their legacies. 1802 Receipts in full for legatees: William, John, Joshua and Daniel Jackson. Acct of Robert Jackson
