Stephen James, "Of Cobb Co.", Campbell Co. WB A, P. 29, dtd 6/24/1840, pvd 5/2/1842, naming w, Mary and children. Issue:

I. Stephen James, Jr., b. 1821 Newbern, N. C., m. 1840 Martha Shipleigh, b. 1820. He was farmer, J. P. of Campbell Co., d. 1871. Issue: W. A. James, lawyer, Douglasville, b. 5/7/1847 Campbell Co., Confed. Soldier, 3rd Ala., Cav., settled Douglasville, Douglas Co. in 1873. 1876-1881, he moved to his mother's plantation near Lithia Springs, become Mayor of Douglasville 1885-6, 1892-4. m. 1/15/1879 Mary M., dau. of William P.

and Mary [McLarty] Strickland. W. A. James had five children: Clifford M.; Ruby L.; Nettie P.; William P.; and James. Another son of Stephen James, Jr. was Joseph S. James, U. S. District Atty, Nor. dist. of Ga., b. Campbell Co., 3/20/1849 m. 1869 Margaret Elizabeth, dau. of E. W. Maxwell of Douglas Co. He was the first Mayor of Douglasville, 1876; 1886 Senator, U. S. District Attorney, 1893. Issue: Margaret Odessa; Eunice Lettitia; Lois Cleveland; George W., d. Front Royal, Va. in war; John M., 1st Lt., Co., A. 21st Ga. Regt, C. S. A.; and William A. Memoirs of Georgia published these two sketches.
