

Jesse Lane, b. 7/3/1733 Halifax Co., N. C., removed to Ga. ca 1784, m. Winifred Aycock, b. 4/11/1741, d. 1794, in 1755. Jesse Lane was an officer during the Revolutionary War, in 3rd N. C. Contl, and served with his son, John Lane, in Battle of Kings Mtn, N. C. He lived in Oglethorpe Co., then Jackson Co., finally Clarke Co., Ga. where he d. 1806. Issue:

I. Charles Lane, b. 10/2/1756 m. Elizabeth Mallory, lived in Franklin Co., having over 1000 acres of land belonging to his wife on Grove River and Chandler's Creek, pt. of which lies in northern pt. of Jackson Co. Also, on 1790, 1792 Wilkes Co. Tax Digest, he declared 1087 1/2 acres in Franklin Co, 250 acres Wilkes Co; presumably, this land was his wife's. The first record of him in Franklin Co. was a land grant dtd 5/17/1784. In determining the names of children of Charles Lane, it became necessary to see which Lanes lived in Franklin Co., and from an extensive search, it appears that Charles Lane and his family were the only Lanes there in the early days. Some of his brothers were listed on tax digest sd county, but in default. Charles Lane lived in that portion of Franklin Co. which later became Jackson Co. Issue follows:

1. Kitchen Lane, b. ca 1778 Halifax Co., N. C., listed on 1799 Jackson Co. Ga. tax digest, in default, owning land in Clarke Co.

2. Sampson Lane, wife, Polly, the first record of him in Franklin Co. was where he wtd a deed in 1792. P. 82, Franklin Co. Mts. (1786-1813), in 1808 Sampson Lane was apptd gdn of Isaiah Beason. There are many deeds in Franklin Co. of Sampson Lane, dating from 1795 to 1818. He owned a great deal of land on Stephens Creek, running a grist mill there, on Nails Creek and Crocketts Creek.

3. John Lane. John and Sampson Lane wtd a deed in Franklin Co. 1793, and were listed on 1800 Franklin Co. Tax Book. There are numberless deeds in Franklin Co. for him, dating from 1790 to 1806, in one dtd 1795, Betsey Lane, wife of John, relinquishes her dower, and in another, his son, John Lane, Jr. is mentioned.

4. Laban Lane, b. 1780 Halifax Co., N. C., listed 1805 Jackson Co. land lottery, 1817 Madison Co. tax digest; 1820 Walton Co. Census; 1830 Madison Co. Census. Laban Lane d. 1833, Madison Co., Ga., leaving two minor children, Harrison Green Lane and James Clayton Lane. William Lane apptd gdn of children, last ann. return dtd 1836. His son, James Clayton Lane, gives father's place of birth as N. C., on 1880 Census. They family lived at Danielsville, Ga., where some of them are buried. Issue follows:

C. and was married soon after the Revolution to Richard Lane; the winter of 1783-4 they moved to Wilkes Co., now Oglethorpe Co., Ga., where her first husband died. XIV. Winifred Lane, b. 10/11/1780 m. James Peleg Rogers, listed on 1805 Jackson Co., Ga. land lottery.
