

Thomas Morgan, b. ca 1680, son of James Morgan who had Thomas, James and Sarah. He was b. Bucks Co, Pa., m. in Md., Rebecca Alexander, the dau. of Martin and Susanna Alexander of Md. His w. d. bef. 1778. Thomas Morgan d. 1778 in Savannah, Ga. The family lived in Pa., Orange Co., N. C., and Ga. Issue: John, Thomas, Luke, Lemuel, Sarah who m. John Blair, Ann, who m. Benjamin Hart, Rev. War Soldier at Kettle Creek. Sarah m. 2d Squire Boone, the parents of Daniel Boone of Ky, Daniel Boone being b. 2/11/1735 Bucks Co., Pa. Nancy who m. Benjamin Hart was m. one of Georgia's War Heroes.

Luke Morgan, Sr., son of Thomas, left his LWT Wilkes Co., Ga, dtd 6/13/1781, naming children, Luke John, Jr., Stokely, and William. Luke, Sr. and his son, William, fought in Battle of Kettle Creek in Wilkes Co. Ga during American Revolution. Cert. of Elijah Clark, Col., dtd 2/2/1784, entitled Luke Morgan to bounty land in Washington Co. Wilkes Co. DB DD, 12/12/1787, John Morgan of Wilkes Co. to Richard Neclear, 200 acres on Long Creek, Franklin Co., Ga., John Morgan to receive 287 1/2 acres on Lone Creek, 7/8/1784. Certificates from Elijah Clark, Col. for bounty land i.e., 2/2/1784, 287 1/2 acres; 7/9/1784, 230 acres Greenbrier Creek in Washington Co.; 2/2/1784, Washington Co. Issue of Luke Morgan, Sr. follows:

III. Luke John Morgan, Jr., b. 12/1777, d. 5/1841 Stewart Co., Ga., listed 1830 Bibb Co. Census and 1840 Stewart Co. Census. Issue follows:

Nannie Sheppard, b. 1852 Webster Co., Ga.; Gus; Robert; Frank; and Emma, all b. Stewart Co. Ga. William Solomon Morgan had a son, Franklin E. Morgan of Terrell Co., Ga.

William Morgan of Jackson Co., Ga., his LWT dtd 4/26/1809, pvd 5/1/1809, WB A, P. 125-6, Jackson Co., names wife, Priscilla, leaving negroes, cattle, hogs, sheep, geese, etc., and bequeathes slaves to each of his children. Issue: Patsy Morgan m. James Sheppard 1/19/1809 Jackson Co., Ga.; Blake M. Morgan; William M. Morgan m. Milly Newbern 2/7/1823 Jackson Co.; Joice M. Morgan; Esther Morgan m. 3/7/1823 Hosea Gideon Jackson Co.; Jesse Morgan m. Duleena Bishop 8/15/1827 Jackson Co.,; and Mahala Morgan.

John Morgan, Sr., Rev. War Soldier, his LWT dtd 1829, pvd in Morgan Co., WB 1814-1830, names sons: William, Asberry, Randall, Nicholas, James and Hobson. Grandchildren: Reuben Morgan and Agnes Carter. Admr., James B. Morgan. Hobson Morgan was listed 1830 Morgan Co. Census; Randall and Nicholas listed on 1830 Monroe Co. Census.
