The Burke and Screven Co. Parkers stem from Hardy Parker, listed on 1786-1810 Duplin Co., N. C. records. He was b. ca 1749, the son of John Parker, his LWT 1788 New Hanover Co., N. C. and w., Eliza. In 1769 Hardy was Petit Juror in Hanover Co., N. C., 1774 juror. Drew land grants in Burke Co., Ga. 1805, 1814. He m. 4/19/1785 Duplin Co., N. C., Susana Bowzer and had nine children, as follows:

In 1817 Hardy Parker, Sr. was J. P. Montgomery Co., Ga. 1818 he was gtd headright grant for Rev. War service. Listed on 1820 Emanuel Co. Ga. Census; Capt. of that Militia Dist. 1820-23. In 1821 he drew in Land Lottery, Walton Co., Land Lot 7, 4th Section, while living in Emanuel Co. The Southern Recorder. "Dooly County, Elizabeth Parker, admx. of Hardy Parker, decd, will sell at his late residence in said county on June 4th next the personal property of the estate. March 15, 1830."

In 1774 Thomas Parker was Juror in New Hanover Co., N. C. Asa Parker was b. Duplin Co. 1775, his bro., Jacob Parker, who lived in Jefferson Co., Ga. 1820; and sister, Sarah, b. 1769 Duplin Co. N. C. who m. Thomas McCanne. In 1780 Duplin Co., N. C., William Parker died; in 1788 Duplin Co., John Parker died. In 1791, Hardy, James and Gabriel were jurors in New Hanover Co., N. C. John Parker's LWT 1788 Duplin Co., N. C. named: Peter, Elizabeth, Sarah, Rachel and Mary. The LWT of William Parker named Jerusha, Susannah, Jenkins, Mary, Cherry and Esther. Jacob Parker of Duplin Co., N. C. drew 50 acres in Burke Co., Ga. 1789, and 1792. Listed on 1820 Burke Co. Ga. Census, age 45 and over.

Gabriel Parker named in LWT of John Parker 5/11/1791 Edgecombe Co., N. C., and is bequeathed the plantation after his mother, Mary, dies. Other issue: John, Aron, William Ammons, Margrit and Elizabeth. Gabriel was found in New Hanover Co., N. C. 1794; issued headright grant 1795 Burke Co., Ga., 1795 in Effingham Co. In 1805 land lottery, drew land in Jefferson and Screven Co.s, Ga. Listed 1820 Montgomery Co. Census. He also drew in 1827 land lottery of Dooly Co., was Lt. in Ga. Militia from Dooly Co. 1827-30, and d. 1829 Dooly Co., Ga. In 1812 he was gtd 460 acres in Screven Co., to the sou. of him, lands of William Parker, to north, Caleb Parker.

Caleb Parker, Rev. War Soldier, served 9th Va. Regt., Continental Line, was Lt. in Screven Co. Ga. 1812. 11/18/1812, Caleb Parker from Screven Co. Ga. deeds to Elizabeth Clifton 100 acres on n.e. side of Great Ogeechee River, Screven Co. Hubbard Parker, Rev. War Soldier from N. C., listed Effingham Co. 1797, Montgomery Co., Ga. 1797, 1800-1810 deeds, Tattnall Co. William Parker recd 1790 headright grant in Burke Co., Ga., in Emanuel Co. 1826, m. 1809 Bathsheba Matthews, in Jefferson Co., Ga.

Moses Parker, Sr., b. 1725 Mass., removed to Chowan Co., N. C. 1750, thence Cheraw dist. S. C. 1760. Moved Greene Co. Ga. where he d. 12/1798, his LWT pvd 1799 Greene Co. Issue: Moses, b. 1748 Mass, d. Greene Co. m. 1st Miss Breedlove, 2d Ann Parker; John, d. 1794 Greene Co., w., Sarah, issue: John, Peter, Elisha, William; Daniel, b. 3/12/1750 in Washington Co. Ga. 1805, had a son, Moses, b. 10/31/1773, d. 1852 Dickson Co. Tenn.; and Priscilla Ann, b. 1796, d. 1880.
