

Peter Perkins granted 500 acres St. Paul's Parish, Ga. in 1770; in 1788 granted 200 acres Wilkes Co., Ga., 1784 granted 287 acres Washington Co. Peter was b. ca 1740, his LWT dtd 3/26/1801 Warren Co., Ga., pvd 2/16/1803. His w., Sarah, d. 1819, when Jethro Darden was apptd admr of her est, 11/1/1819, P. 26, Warren Bk A, Admrs Bonds. Issue follows:

In 1770 Peter Perkins was gtd lot in Wrightsboro, Ga., which he later sold in 1797 (in Wilkes Co.), removing to Warren Co. on Upton Cr. Warren DB B, P. 214-5, Peter Perkins, late of Warren Co., made his LWT dtd 3/6/1800, with John Torrence and John Baker, exrs., sold to John Darden, the highest bidder, 196 acres on Williams Creek.

Archibald Perkins, Rev. War Soldier, drew in Ga. 1832 Land Lottery, of Greene Co. According to McCall's Roster of Revolutionary War Soldiers, he was b. N. C. 1744, of Scotch-Welsh descent, m. in Va. 1764 to Elizabeth Gibbs, and d. aged 96 yrs. His LWT dtd 7/3/1834 Greene Co., Ga., pvd 11/1840. He was Pvt. in N. C. Troops, fought at Battle of Guilford Courthouse, and began purchasing land in Greene Co., Ga. in 1791, first 575 acres, then 200 acres on Old Town Creek. Issue follows:

- III. Alexander Perkins, b. 2/8/1795 Greene Co., Ga., m. Selete Jernigan, Hancock Co., 12/26/1815, her bro., Seaborn Jernigan. Alexander svd War of 1812, lived Monroe Co. 1830, and was alive 1891, according to Memoirs of Georgia. Issue follows:

1. A. L. Perkins, lived first Greene Co. five yrs, then removed to Jasper Co. for two years. In 1823 he removed to Monroe Co., Ga., having eight children. He was b. 1/25/1827, d. 3/26/1892, from Memoirs of Georgia. This was Alexander Lee Perkins who m. Mary Jane Ponder, 12/20/1849 Monroe Co., Ga.

William Perkins of Greene Co., Ga., b. ca 1750, d. 1816 Greene Co., Ga., m. 1772 Sarah Walker, d. 1819 Greene Co, her LWT dtd 12/17/1818, pvd 1/1819 Greene Co., Bk 4, P. 26. Issue follows:

I. Walker Perkins, b. 1780/85, his LWT dtd 3/25/1819 Greene Co., pvd 5/1819, naming bros., Ezekiel and William; sister, Sarah Cook, and Alexander Robinson to be repaid.

III. Ezekiel Perkins m. Sally English 2/1/1810 Greene Co., Ga.

IV. William Perkins m. Polly Harp 1/30/1805 Greene Co., listed 1820 Morgan Co. Census, his LWT, Bk C, P. 238-43, Morgan Co. Wills, dtd 5/26/1856, naming w., Prudence M. and issue: Elizabeth Ann m. VI. Constantine Perkins, b. ca 1777, m. Polly Perkins 1/9/1797 Greene Co., Ga., his LWT dtd 11/15/1814, pvd 5/6/1816, Morgan Co. W B B, P. 21, naming w., Polly, implying his only child is Zeno Perkins. Mentions "My part of my father's estate." Wit: Sally B. Perkins, etc.

Newton Perkins, Sr. of Burke Co., Ga., was b. 11/20/1778 New Hanover Co., N. C., d. 9/10/1887, bur. Wallace Cemetery, Jenkins Co., Ga. Listed 1805 Ga. Land Lottery from Burke Co., and 1850 census. There were 27 slaves mentioned in his Will. He m. 1st Pharabe Wallace, dau. of William Wallace of N. C., b. 2/11/1792, d. 11/26/1834, and 2d, Sarah Frances Lester, called "Nancy", on 3/2/1837. Issue follows:

deed records; in Jasper Co. from 1809 to 1824; gtd 200 acres Wilkes Co. 1788. The est. of John Morgan, Franklin Co., pd. Moses Perkins 1/10/1796. Moses owned land on Ward's Cr. Franklin Co., and on waters of Double Bridge 1813. Jasper Co. Ga. Mts., V. I, P. 43, Moses Perkins sec. on est. William Ballard, decd. Randolph-Jasper Co. Misc. Ests, Est. of John Mosses, decd, retns 1813, 1814, names Moses Perkins, admr; and named as gdn of John Mosses 1809-1816. The LWT of Moses Perkins dtd 10/7/1816, pvd 5/8/1824 Jasper Co. Bk 4H, P. 174, mentions "my youngest children", inv. of his est. P. 215-216. 1827 Ga. Land Lottery, Jasper Co. names "orphans of Moses Perkins."

Elijah Perkins of Habersham Co., Ga., b. ca 1780 N. C., listed 1810-20 Burke Co., N. C. Census, and 1830 Habersham Co., Ga. Census. He first bt land in Habersham Co. 1828 on Ward's Creek, and 1834 was member of Camp Creek Baptist Church, along with w., Mary. Issue follows:

I. Reuben B. Perkins, b. 1803 Burke Co., N. C., m. ca 1829 Habersham Co., Ga., Martha Ann, listed 1830 Franklin Co. Census, 1840-70 DeKalb Co. Census, drawing in 1827 land lottery, res. Habersham Co.

Abington Perkins of Wilkes Co., Ga., b. ca 1740, granted ceded lands in Wilkes Co., Ga. 10/12/1773, 100 acres Savannah River, at that time from N. C., having w., son and two daus, ages 7 to 3. Wilkes Co. DB AA, P. 59: "To son, Jesse Perkins, all that plantation on which I live, containing 100 acres...on Savannah River." 3/1/1786. Wilkes DB AA, P. 58: "To my daughter, Averilla Perkins, cattle, 3/4/1786," with Benjamin and Jesse Perkins, testators. Issue follows:

Moses Perkins of Wilkes Co., Ga., b. Halifax Co., N. C., registered his brand in Wilkes Co. Ga. 1777; from 1798 to 1807 found in Franklin Co. Ga.
