Mark Tapley, Rev. War Soldier of S. C., was decd 1788 in Columbia Co. Ga. Warren Co. DB B, P. 310-311, 8/6/1793, Philip Pool and Mary, exrs. and New Tapley, Elizabeth Tapley, Judith Wilder and William Tapley, heirs of Joel Tapley, decd, to Henry Harp, for 12 pounds, 50 acres in Columbia Co. Ga. on Rocky Comfort Creek, part of a grant of 287 1/2 acres granted to H heirs of Mark Tapley 8/15/1788. Only known issue of Mark:

DB B, P. 514-515, 5/10/1790, William Bush and Mourning, his w., of Wilkes Co. to Joel Tapley of Richmond Co., 200 acres, Richmond Co., e.s. Beachtree Cr., wit: James Homphill, Evin Tapley. Issue:

4. New Tapley, decd in 1812, his descendants removed to Emanuel Co., with a son, James in Montgomery Co. Issue:

Emanuel Co. 1830, and his grandfather was one of the three bros. who came from England to N. C. just before the Rev. War and served in the Continental Army; that his father was James Tapley and mother Mary Benson, dau. of Josiah Benson. Montgomery Co. Ga. Mts. 1809-1819, 3/2/1812, Application of James Tapley to sell 150 acres in Warren Co. on Rocky Comfort Creek, 202 1/2 acres in Wilkinson Co., being the est. of New Tapley, decd. 3/30/1816, James Tapley apptd admr. Est. of New Tapley. There is a marriage of Newhampton Tapley to Sanny Silver 5/11/1817 Putnam Co. Ga. She md. 2d Jesse Moore 2/14/1821 Baldwin Co. Ga.

Hosea Tapley, Sr., his LWT dtd 6/1781 Caswell Co. N. C., names Sarah, w., and son, Hosea, as follows:

I. Hosea Tapley, Jr., b. ca 1730, d. 1770 Orange Co. N. C., his LWT dtd 3/21/1770, m. Lucy Pryor. Granville Co. N. C. deeds - Bk A, P. 80-81, 12/13/1748 Hosea Tapley of Northampton Co. N. C. to William Short, 640 acres in Granville Co.; P. 305-6, 5/22/1750, William Short to Hosea Tapley of Northampton Co., planter, 640 acres in Craven Co., both sides of Richlands Spring Creek, a prong of Flat River. 1753-1758, Hosea was witnessing deeds in Granville Co. His Will - "This day came Victory Rankin and made oath that she was at Hosea Tapley, Jr., before he died, and he said his land was to go to sons, John Pryor Tapley and Hosea Tapley; one part to go to another son, if his wife has one." wit: John Pryor, affidavit 3/22/1770.* Issue:

1. Hosea Tapley, b. ca 1770 Granville Co., N. C., removed to Pendleton dist, S. C., on 1800 Census. 2/4/1799 Pendleton d. S. C., Thos. C. Russell and w. Mary of Lincoln Co. Ga. to Hosea Tapley of Pendleton, 200 acres on Coneross Creek. Harriett Russell, John Tapley, witnesses.

2. John Pryor Tapley, b. ca 1770 Granville Co., N. C. There are deeds in Anderson Co. S. C., "John Tapley of Pendleton district," dtg 1803, 1802. Hancock Co. Ga. deed 2/2/1797, John Tapley of Pendleton d., S. C. to Jonathan Davis of Hancock Co. Ga., 47 acres on Dry Creek.
