- The LWT of Anne Bacon Dixon dtd 8/21/1833, pvd 3/2/1835 Talbot Co., Ga., names her dau., Mary B. Tennille and gr-son, Francis T. Tennille.
- Francis Tennille owned over 6000 acres, 57 slaves, and the notice of his death was presented before Ga. Legislature. Issue follows:
