Nathan Veal, b. 1740/1750 Va., d. 1833 Washington Co. Ga., m. 3/18/1785 Jane Milstead, spinster, Amherst Co., Va., dau. of Joseph and Rebecca Milstead. Nathan Veal, Sr. was listed on 1790 Amherst Co., Va. Census, 1805 Ga. Land Lottery, Hancock Co. Hancock Bk G, P. 25-6, 1/23/1802, Jonathan Miller to Nathan Veal, both of Hancock Co., 150 acres on Tigar Creek. Listed 1830 Washington Co. Ga. Census. Hancock DB I, P. 115-7, 10/4/1808, Nathan Veal of Washington Co. to Moses Brown, 150 acres on Tigar Creek. Washington Co. L/A & Gdn, 1829-75, Bk A, P. 44: "Whereas, Synthia Veal, idiot child of Nathan Veal, is possessed in her own right of considerable estate...we commit the tuition, education and guardianship of said idiot to you, the said Reuben Bullington....7/6/1840." Also, "....Edward Veal, Bryant Oguire and Alexander Giles are held and firmly bound....this first day of July 1833...the condition....is such that of the above bound, Edward Veal, is this day appointed guardian of the person and property of Synthia Veal, orphan and minor of Nathan Veal, deceased. John Veal served in War of 1812, his application for pension approved 1871; he was a large landowner in DeKalb Co, having 17 slaves in 1860. 11/7/1887. J. M. Griffin and A. J. Veal, adjrs., were given leave to sell his land and distribute his estate, Carroll Co. Buried on farm in Carroll Co. now owned by his gr-gdau, Mrs. Curtis Wilson, Carrollton.

10. John Lafayette Veal was tax collector of Carroll Co., 1871, left his widow 275 acres Carroll Co. Issue:
