Samuel Walden made LWT dtd 1770 Halifax Co., Va., naming legatees: Richard, Owen, William, Lewis and Elijah Walden, all sons. According to an affidavit made by Elisha Dismukes, Pittsylvania Co., Va., 12/9/1818 Samuel Walden m. 1st Jane Sills having by her Samuel, Jr., and m. 2d, Elisha Dismukes' sister, Mary Dismukes, having issue, Richard, William, Lewis, Elijah, Frances, Sarah and Ann. Bible of Samuel Walden owned by Mrs. R. Shaefer Heard, West Point, Ga. names issue as follows:
