George Walton, Gentleman, b. ca 1680, LWT dtd 7/7/1764, pvd 1/26/1767, WB 3, P. 517-518, Brunswick Co., Va. m. Elizabeth Rowe, b. 2/15/1685 Middlesex Co., Va. (Virginia Magazine, V. 38, P. 175), her LWT dtd 2/12/1771, pvd 7/24/1775, WB 4, P. 444-446, Brunswick Co., Va. Removed from King Wm. Co., Va. to Brunswick Co., Va. ca 1726; made deed of lease and release to John Hall, Prince Geo. Co., Va. in 1732, DB I, P. 172; he was apptd King's Justice Gentleman at first court held in Brunswick Co. 5/11/1732; took oath of High Sheriff of Brunswick Co. 11/7/1734; oath of Judge of Chancery 6/5/1746; was Capt. of Infantry in Va. Colonial Militia, 8/1748, having issue:

Gazette, "Thomas Walton died, age 67, of Lincoln Co., d. 4/16/1806, left widow." Lincoln Co. Estates, 9/1/1806, Noah, minor of Thomas Walton, Sr., John Walton, Gdn: Elizabeth, minor of Thomas, Sr., with Thomas, Gdn. "My father's old tract left to sons." Known as "Colonel". Married three times, first to: "Mrs. S. Walton, died 5/7/1802, 22 years old, wife of Colonel John H. Walton of Lincoln Co." Georgia Gazette. Married 2d, America, b. 1786, d. 1806. Georgia Gazette,  
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"Mrs. America Walton, age 19, wife of Colonel John Walton, died 4/9/1806, Lincoln Co." Md. 3rd Polly Walker, Lincoln Co. Ga. 1/14/1808, and 4th Nancy H., who remd W. W. Stokes. John Walton was Lt. Col. in 1798, Lincoln Co., listed in 1805 and 1820 land lotteries. Issue:

Hon. George Walton, Governor of Georgia, b. 1749 Prince Edward Co., Va. Columbian Museum & Savannah Advertiser, 2/11/1804: "Honorable George Walton died 2/2/1804, age 55, Augusta, Justice of Superior Court of Georgia, native of Virginia, came to Georgia age 18." Memoirs of Georgia, V. I, p. 228, "George Walton, Governor of Georgia [1789-1790], and signer of the Declaration of Independence, was born in Prince Edward county, Va. in 1749. He was left an orphan at an early age and served an apprenticeship in carpentering...When about twenty years of age he migrated to Savannah, where he began to study law...In 1777 he married Dorothy Camber...."

Columbian Museum & Savannah Advertiser, 12/24/1803: "Died at Meadow Gardens, near Augusta, Tues., 13th, Thomas C. Walton, attorney, eldest son of Hon. George Walton."

Hon. Robert Walton, b. 1754. Augusta Chronicle & Gazette of the State, 8/23/1800: "Died at Richmond Co. on 20th inst., Hon. Robert Walton, age 46, for several years Senator of this State and President of the State Senate and one of the Justices of the Inferior Court of Richmond County...took a commission for service in the revolution...married after peace...."

Southern Patriot, 1/19/1805: "William Walton of Savannah died, the eldest son of Robert Walton, esq., late of Richmond Co."
