Mitchell Watkins, b. ca 1745 N. C., d. 1845 Washington Co., Ga., m. three times, first and second to Lodge sisters, 3rd, Elizabeth Hill. By the first two marriages, he had Reddin, Levin, Delphia Wealthy, and Richard, and by Elizabeth Hill had: William Mitchell, Isaac H., Lucinda, Sindrilla and Phonetta. He migrated to Ga. ca 1800, was surveyor, Rev. War Soldier from N. C., and at one time owned 16 slaves. He had a bro., Levin Watkins who was several times State Senator in N. C. and member of 1879 State Constitutional Convention.

William Mitchell, b. 1804, d. 1883 Washington Co., Ga. m. Sarah Cherry, b. 1803 N. C. and had issue: Lucy H., Martha A., Lafayette W., William E., Mitchell and Marion Wiley. Marion Wiley Mitchell was b. 1843 in Washington Co., Ga., d. 1888 Calhoun Co., Ga. m. Clara H. Tennille, dau. of Robert Tennille, and had: Minnie Lee, Memphis A., Mattie Lou Ida, Carrie Eugenia, Tilden W., Mamie Bell, Hyman T., Sallie Reed, and Covington Holmes b. 1881, d. 1938 m. Belle Saxon and had Robert E., b. 1903, d. 1964 m. Ouida Smith and Annette. Robert E. had C. Robert Watkins, b. 12/17/1931 Edison, Ga., m. Martha Carter Jackson, dau. of Dr. Miquel W. Jackson and Westelle Harvey Jackson on 4/4/1959, and had issue: Robert J., b. 7/16/1960; Helen C., b. 3/16/1963; and Mitchell W., b. 2/7/1965.
