

Thomas Watts, Sr., Judge of Ct. of Ordinary, Fauquier Co., Va., 1753-4, LWT dtd 7/22/1769, pvd 8/28/1769 Fauquier Co., Va., naming Thomas Watts, Jr.; Susannah Watts m. Jeremiah Strother; Frances Watts, b. 1751 m. Fauquier Co., Va., William Hansborough; and Evy Watts m. Mr. Cockerhill.

Thomas Watts, Jr., b. 2/14/1747 Old Prince Wm., Co., Va., d. 10/10/1798 Greene Co., Ga., LWT dtd 6/20/1790 m. Hannah Rust Bogges, b. 8/15/1753 Fauquier Co., Va., d. 9/18/1820 Ga., dau. of Thomas Bogges. She m. 2d 11/1/1802 Matthew Rabun, father of Gov. William Rubun of Georgia, b. 5/15/1744, d. 1819, no issue. Thomas Watts listed in Capt. Hagin's dist., Wilkes Co., Ga., 1785 tax digest, and with a deed of Francis Trawick and w., Ann to Thomas Bartee of Cumberland Co., Va. 11/18/1790, Wilkes Co., Ga., with Richard Watts. Issue of Thomas Watts, Jr. follows:

I. Jacobus Watts m. 2/24/1804 Elizabeth Harrison, Greene Co., Ga. The Southern Recorder 6/14/1825: "Died on May 20th, Capt. Jacobus Watts, age 53, at his residence in the vicinity of the Standing Peachtree in DeKalb County. Had long been a citizen of Greene County and a member of the legislature from that county; later moving to Morgan County where he was a Justice of the Inferior Court. Wife and a respectable family."

III. Archibald Watts, d. Greene Co., Ga., division of his estate, 1821, orphans, Ann Eliza, Sarah, Jubal; Archibald C.; Richard, Thomas, David, Mary and Martha.

V. Jubal Watts, his LWT dtd 8/8/1831, pvd 9/5/1831 Greene Co., Ga.

VI. Harrison Watts, his LWT dtd 10/8/1814, pvd 1/2/1815 Greene Co., Ga., Jacobus Watts, exr. Rene Fitzpatrick, gdn of orphans, later exr, Hampton Watts. Wife, Polly, who m. 1/15/1816 Greene Co., Ga., Rene Fitzpatrick and had: Thalia Fitzpatrick m. Dr. Dubose; Caroline Cornelia Fitzpatrick, b. 2/17/1819 m. Dr. Stephen Horton of Ala. and had ten children; Benjamin Fitzpatrick; Sip Fitzpatrick, b. 1817, of La. Fitzpatrick Bible from Lorraine W. Thompson, Jackson, Miss. Greene Co., Ga. deed, Bk 4, P. 631, Harrison Watts from William Crocker, for \$550, 12/2/1809, "the plantation whereon said Crocker at present lives," lands on Greenbrier Creek, 150 acres. Greene Co. WB E, P. 130, Harrison Watts, LWT dtd 10/8/1814 names Jacobus Watts his exr. and Polly Watts, wife, extx. Cash pd. R. Fitzpatrick, gdn. of Mary H. Watts, Martha A. Watts, and Harrison L. Watts, minors of Harrison Watts, decd, as their share of hire of negroes and rent of land for 1820. Issue of Harrison Watts follows:

Removed to Butler Co., Ala. and had issue: Thomas Hill Watts, b. 1/3/1819 d. 9/16/1892 m. 1/10/1842 Eliza Brown Allen; Wily Watts, b. 3/20/1820, d. 8/27/1855 m. Mary Paul; John Hughes Watts, b. 11/23/1821, d. 7/15/1850; Fanata Watts, b. 4/6/1828, d. 7/1/1860 m. James Steen; Prudence Hill Watts, b. 5/3/1830, d. 7/22/1850 m. Robert Steen; Amanda Watts, b. 4/11/1834, d. 3/2/1901, m. Augustus Murphy; Augustine Watts, b. 3/15/1836, d. 12/7/1858, m.
