Charles Whitehurst, b. ca 1780/1790 N. C., d. Wilkinson Co., Ga. 1840. Listed 1830 Wilkinson Co. Ga. Census. From <u>History of Wilkinson County</u>, P. 623:

"The Whitehurst name is an old and honorable one. The history of arms of the family records that three brothers fought with honor with the English in the Crusades. The early settlers of the Whitehurst family who came to America established themselves in Virginia and North Carolina. Charles Whitehurst and his wife, Elizabeth, were the first of the family to settle in Wilkinson County, Georgia. They came from North Carolina. They bought a large tract of land 17 1/2 miles from Macon, Georgia, near the line of Jones County.... Charles and Elizabeth Whitehurst had four sons and two daughters, Josiah Irwin, Charles C., Howell Little, Esther, Jachan, and James Stanley. Josiah Irwin bought from the other heirs their interests in his father's estate. Charles moved to Houston County. Howell to Bibb County, and James went to Texas.
