- Newspaper, The Daily Citisen, Vicksburg, Mississippi, July 2, 1863, one page, printed on the back of a piece of wallpaper.
- 3. Paper on suits of armor, by Mr. Ed. Willis.
- 4. Letter from Robert M. Hughes to Mrs. Belle Virgin, May 22, 1888.
- 5. Letter from Col. J. Taylor Wood to Coll Wymess, April 4, 1865, giving President Jefferson Davis' camp chest to Col. Wymess.
- 6. Record of events of the "Irwin Guards," Co. A, 9th Regiment Georgia Volunteer Infantry, later assigned to the 11th Battalion Georgia Light Artillery as Co. E (later Co. C.) This record, covering the period from June 14, 1861 to November, 1864, was apparently compiled from a diary.
