

Referring to your letter of the 28th ultime, in which you request to be furnished with the military record of Captain J. J. Colhoun, who, it is stated, served in Company K, 18th Alabama Regiment, and in Company C, 6th South Carolina Cavalry, Confederate States Army, and surrendered at Greensboro, North Carolina, in 1865, I have the honor to inform you that the records of this office show that one J. J. Calhoun (surname not found as Colhoun), Captain Company K, 18th Regiment, Alabama Infantry, Confederate States Army, enlisted August 3, 1861, at Alpine, Alabama. On the company roll dated December 31, 1861, the last roll on which his name is borne, he was reported "absent on furlough, December 23, 1861," and on the Regimental return for January 1862, "as sick in General Hospital, Mobile."
