



# NOTES.

In order to avoid unnecessary delays to applicants, and to enable all parties interested to understand the laws granting allowances to disabled soldiers, as well as the rules adopted by the Governor touching the payments provided, the following suggestions are submitted.

1. If an applicant has been wounded, the description of the wound should be carefully and fully set forth by applicant and physicians, and followed by a plain statement of facts showing the extent of the disability. If applicant claims disability from disease contracted in the service, a full and carefully stated history of the disease should be given, tracing the disability by positive proofs to the service.

2. The law makes no allowance for an arm or a leg, unless the arm or leg has been rendered substantially stated.

2. The law makes no allowance for an arm or a leg unless the arm or leg has been rendered substantially and essentially useless.

3. It will not answer to say that an arm is "substantially useless for ordinary pursuits of life, etc."

There is no qualification to the clause of the Act in reference to the arm or leg, but the limb must for all purposes be "substantially and essentially useless."


4. If the application is for a wounded leg, it would seem to be a fair construction of the Act, and the words above quoted, to say that unless the injury is such as to require the constant use of cruich or stick, that the leg is not "substantially and essentially useless."

5. If papers are returned for correction, and amendments are added to any of the affidavits, the amendments must be made under oath before an officer, and the proofs must show that the amendments have been duly sworn to.

6. Every application must be certified by the Ordinary of the country of the residence of the applicant. The certificate of any other will not be received in any case.

The Ordinaries of the several countles are specially requested to call the attention of the physiciams and applicants to these points.







Complying with the 'phone request of Mr. Askew, I am stating the particulars of the death of Wr. John S. Langley, late of this (Campbell) county, and other circumstances and facts as to claims on his pension money, as understood by me, and send and papers connected. I am informed that said deceased fell while leaving dining table, and hit his head against a nail or tack, causing a bad wound which bled very profusely- was at once carried by auto by Mr. H. H. Cook, a near neighbor to nearest Physician, Dr. T. P. Bullard, of Palmetto, Ga .that Dr. B., after dressing said wound, requested Dr. W. R. Camp, of this town, to have said deceased transferred to Hospital .. But. as deceased had no funds with which to pay Hospital bills, Dr. C. was almost forced to take him, temporarily to Pauper Home, where he was taken care of until his death, Apr. 24, last, after he had been in said P. Home about 10 days. At texas he received his wound, he was staying with Mr. Will Ray, and was never an inmate of, or regularly admitted to, said P. Home. as carried there in the emergency, to remain until better arrangements could be made. His wife was divorced from him, and he had no home, except as provided by said Mr. Raythat Mr, Ray had loaned him at least \$25.00, and probably more. I understand that a sister of said deceased promised to /r. Holsomback, the Undertaker, all of such portion of his burial expenses as were not paid by his pension. And I am informed that the Com'rs of R. & Rev. of the county declined to pay such expenses because he was not an inmate of Pauper Home. Yours very truly,
