2. Additional affidavits may be attached if blank spaces are insufficient.
3. Affidavits made before an Ordinary of any County, Jan. 1st, 1891, are entitled.
4. All affidavits must be made before the Ordinary of the residence of the person to be sworn and certified by said Ordinary.
5. Always certified copies of marriage licenses if obtainable. If not, prove marriage, by some person, or by general reputation.
