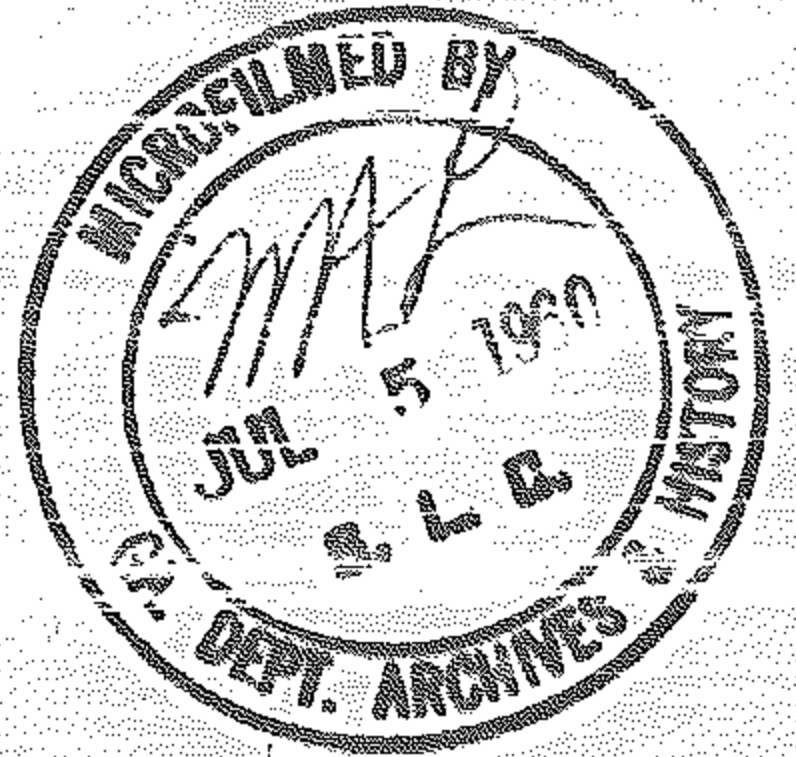

 mother and surrounding by James G. White
 was tried before Judge W B Thomas
 and was acquitted
