Notes for Keziah Ponder:

No record of the date and place of birth has been found however it is now assumed that he was born in France about 1665 and he came to this country with his father Nicholas d'Allee on or about 1682.

It appears that John lived for about fifteen years in the Dutch settlements in Essex and Bergen counties. In 1706 he moved to Duck Creek hundred in Kent County.

#### History of the State of Delaware

The Lenni Lenape Indians, later known as Delawares to the English, occupied what is now the state of Delaware before the coming of the Europeans. As white settlements began to encroach on their hunting lands, they gradually moved to Pennsylvania, Ohio, and finally beyond the Mississippi River.

#### The Colonial and Revolutionary Periods

The first European known to have visited Delaware was the English explorer Henry Hudson, who located the Delaware River in 1609. A year later, when the English adventurer Samuel Argall (circa 1580-c. 1626) entered the bay, he named the area after the governor of Virginia, Lord De La Warr. The first permanent settlement, Fort Christina (present-day Wilmington), was established in 1638 by a group of Swedes. It came into being as a joint business venture by Dutch and Swedish interests after former members of the Dutch West India Company interested Gustav II Adolph, king of Sweden, in colonization. The resulting colony was called New Sweden. Finns constituted a good portion of the settlers; they and the Swedes introduced the construction of log houses to America.

Considering it a commercial rival, Governor. Peter Stuyvesant of New Netherland occupied New Sweden in 1655 and renamed it New Amstel. The Dutch were followed by the English, who seized the settlements in 1664. Under English rule, Delaware was at first governed as part of the proprietary colony of New York, and the town of New Castle was the local governmental center.

After 1682, Delaware became part of Pennsylvania and was referred to as the Lower Counties or the Territories. After 1704 the Lower Counties established their own independent legislature. In addition to the English, large numbers of indentured Scotch-Irish settled in the area before the American Revolution. A continued labor shortage led to a slave trade, which flourished until it was prohibited by state law in 1776.

The Lower Counties reluctantly moved toward independence along with the other colonies. In 1776 they adopted a constitution as the state of Delaware. During the Revolution the British occupied Wilmington, seizing the public treasury, and Delaware Bay was blockaded by the Royal Navy. John Allee died in March 1718, in Duck Creek Hundred, his will, executed February 19, 1718, being admitted to probate in Kent county, Delaware, on March 16, 1718 (Vol. D-1, p. 7, Records of Kent county)

John Allee, by his last will and testament, dated Feb. 19, 1718, (executed in the presence Or John Hillyard, Isabell Smith and John Bradshaw, Sr., as witnesses, and proved and admitted to probate in Kent county, Delaware, on March 16, 1718 (Vol. D-1, p. 7, records of Kent County, devised and bequeathed his lands and estate to his children in the following manner:

- a) Unto his eldest sons, Peter and Abraham: the "dwelling plantation", situated between Dawson's branch and Irons' branch of Duck Creek, together with lands lying to the westward, comprising 500 acres, to be divided between them;
- b) Unto his son, Johannus: 300 acres of land at "Beavours Dam Point";
- c) Unto his daughters, Xannah and Mary: 150 acres of land at "Pasture Point";
- d) Unto his son, Jacob: the land and plantation called "Long Point", comprising 150 acres, together with 100 acres "in the neck";
- e) Unto his daughter, Jane, the "wife of Simeon Van Winkle: forty pounds:

f) Unto his daughter, Susannah, "wife of John Van Gasco: Forty pounds:

g) Unto his two youngest daughter, Elizabeth and Rachell: forty pounds, current money to each of them. "to be paid to them when they come to the age of eighteen years;

h) All of the rest and residue unto his sons and daughters: Peter, Abraham, Johannus, Jacob, Hannah and Mary. to be equally divided between them.

The will, however, contained a proviso that in the event Peter Allee should not within three years after the death of his father move to Duck Creek hundred and establish his home on the portion of the dwelling plantation devised and bequeathed to him, then that it should go absolutely to Johannus Allee: and in lieu thereof, Peter Allee should take the lands at "Beavours Dam Point".

The records of the Dutch Reformed Church at Hackensack, New Jersey which start in the year 1686, contain entries covering the baptism of Suannah (1694), Jacob (1699) and Maritie (1704), children of "Jan Allee and Susanna LaRoe"; and the provisions of the last will and testament of John Allee clearly indicate that Peter and Abraham were his eldest sons, and that they, together with his daughters Jane and Hannah and his son Johannus were likewise the issue of his marriage with Susanna LaRoe.

And, while further research it necessary to determine definitely whether the daughters Elizabeth and Rachell were the issue of the first or the second marriage it does appear by John Allee's last will and testament that they were his youngest children; and there is an inference that they were born in the Delaware colony and may have been the issue of his second marriage with Msrille de Grave Terhuyn.

The register of marriage in the archives of the Dutch Reformed church, at Hackensack, N. J., discloses that Maritie de Grave, widow of Andries Tibout, married Albert Terhuynen on Sept. 8, 1705; and that, a9 'widow of Albert Terhuynne, she married John Allee (Jan Allee on Sept. 23, 1709 New Jersey Archives Vol. 22, pp. 471, 481, 503)

Jacques LaRoe, a brother of Susanna LaRoe, was born in 1657 (Riker's History of Harlem", p. 328): established his home in Hackensack in 1678; and married Wynbrecht Hendrickses in the Dutch Reform(d church, at Bergen, N. J., on Jan 2, 1681. He died in 1730, his last will and testament (dated Nov. 14, 1728) being proved and admitted to probate in Bergen county, New Jersey, on Sept. 2, 1730.

A deed from Gawen Lawie to Hundrick Tunis Albert (Liber F, p. 590) bears an endorsement by the grantee dated Oct. 7, 1693, whereby he conveyed the lands therein described to "Jan Allee, farmer, of Essex county". (Calendar of Records in the Office of the Secretary of State, 1664-1703'1, New Jersey Archives, Vol. 21, p. 284.)

While the Dutch Reformed churches were scrupulously careful in keeping registers in their archives of births and marriages, they preferred no records of deaths and funerals-death being but an interlude in the chain of events leading to eternal salvation.
