JOHN STRONG<sup>vii</sup> was b. 1675 in Virginia, m. 1697\_\_\_\_ Sherwood. His sons, John Strong b. 1698, William Strong, b. 1701, George Strong b. 1703 and Nathaniel Strong b. 1704

JOHN STRONG b. 1698 New Kent Co., Va., son of above John Strong, his birth being listed in the New Kent Co. Register, m. Frances and had sons, viz: \*William b. 1730 (his issue follows under separate heading, William Strong), John b. 1739, Martin b. 1739 and Sherwood b. 1745.<sup>viii</sup>

JOHN STRONG b. 1739, his LWT dtd 11/6/1815 Clarke Co., Ga. Exrs were Charles and Robert Strong. He m. Miss Elizabeth Turnbull from England or Scotland, and had issue:

\*William Strong, Sr., a son of William Strong (b. 11/13/1698 New Kent Co., Va.), was b. ca 1730, was found in Georgia about 1785, in the Wilkes, Franklin and Jackson Co. Deeds. One deed, dated 2/26/1796, Franklin Co., William Strong, Jr. to William Strong, Sr., both of Franklin Co., 380 acres in Jackson Co., Ga. Adj. Elijah Strong and others. Issue as follows:

I. William Strong, Jr., son of William Strong, Sr., Rev War Soldier, b. ca 1750, found in early Wilkes Co., Ga. Deeds, i.e., William Strong and his wife, Peggy, deed to John Davis, 200 acres on Fork Creek, originally granted to said William Strong in 1786, 5/21/1789. His LWT dated 8/8/1810, pvd 9/2/1810 Clarke Co., Ga., named wife, Peggy, his children, and his sister, Jane Bridgewater. Jack F. Cook was made guardian of Elijah, Muntford, George Jackson, John, Madison and Harriett Strong, orphans of William Strong on 11/1/1813 Clarke Co., Ga. The Estate of Harriett Strong 7/5/1819, Gabriel A. Moffett, admr. Issue of William Strong, Jr. as follows:

A. Sarah Rachel Strong m. 1st, Jack Fleming Cocke, Clarke Co., Ga. 8/27/1801, and 2nd, Gabriel A. Moffett 7/17/1816 Clarke Co., Ga.
