Dear Mr. Williams:

I have just concluded Georgia records of Meriwether, Stewart, Troup and Franklin Counties as well as Abbeville County, South Carolina records, except the deeds, which I do not have access to here in Atlanta.

My first objective to make certain that Stephen Williams did or did not come to Georgia with his parents. As you will read in the outline below, I think that you will agree that he was the first of his immediately family to venture to Meriwether County.

I personally travelled to Meriwether County and examined all possible records. As you will see from the enclosed deed records, Stephen Williams was speculating on land by buying up the land lotteries awarded in 1827. The first acquisition was Lot 156 in the 8th district which he and Lewis Williams purchased from Isaac Hamby on 2/20/1828 for \$300.00. On 2/27/1828 Stephen and Lewis purchased Lot 136 in the 10th district. Since his first born (Robert) was born in Abbeville County in 1829, he apparently returned home after the first acquisition. He was back in Meriwether County in 1830, this time selling on 1/8th to Pleasant Cox, Lot 47 in the 8th district. (In 1832 he purchased this same lot from Samuel Swilly). On 9/7th of 1830 he purchased land at a Sheriff's Sale in the 11th district, Lot 42.

Stephen must have been back in Abbeville by the summer because he was enumerated on the 1830 Abbeville County Census as follows -

Stephen Williams 1 male under 5, male 20-30, female 10-15, female 15-20
Living next door was the following family -

Nancy Williams, male 20-30, female 40-50 (candidate for Stephen's mother)

And

John Williams male 40-50, female 30-40 (candidate for Stephen's father)

Lewis Williams, born 1770/1780, listed on 1840 Muscogee County Census. Female 5-10, female 15-20, female 50-60, male 60-70. This same Lewis was no doubt the one listed on the 1800 Greenville County Census.

Lewis Williams of Meriwether County also had some deed transactions with David and Elijah Williams of North Carolina. The last record of him in Meriwether County was in March Term of 1846 when he was the administrator of Reuben Williams, and gave bond of \$1000. No further information. A search of the Lewis Williams' in S. C. did not disclose a son of Stephen's age.

Thus eliminating the Lewis possibility as a father, still, there is probably some sort of kinship between Lewis and Stephen. Perhaps they were cousins and the old Rev. War Soldier was their grandfather. I could find nothing on the old soldier; he was not listed in the S. C. or GA records as being a soldier, and never applied for a pension. Since Franklin County records were lost, I would be willing to bet that he filed an application in Franklin County if he lived to about 1832.

The 1820 Abbeville Census disclosed 2 possible parents for Stephen.

Joseph Williams male 26-45, son 10-16, 4 females under 10, female 16-26

John Williams male under 10 male 10-16 male 45 and over female under 10 female 10-16 female 16-26, female 45 and over

John was present in 1830. Joseph was gone.

Notice that Joseph had a son 10-16 (fit's Nancy's son 20-30 in 1830); also 4 female under 10. One of these could be residing with Stephen in 1830.

The generation of John and Joseph fit with that of Robert Williams whose estate was administered on 1/9/1823 in Abbeville County by Joseph and John Williams. Robert must have died before 1820, because he was not listed on the census. Stephen Henderson gave a bond of \$700 on 9/1/1823. Notice of an Estate Sale was published in the Providence Church. Purchasers at the sale were: Miss Sarah Williams, Thomas Williams, Stephen Henderson, Elizabeth Williams, John Williams, etc. Inventory by Richard L. Anderson and William Henderson.

Conclusion: Even though the history of the various Williams families in Abbeville County and Meriwether County are similar, the records do not satisfy a proof of parentage. The only thing left is a search of the Abbeville County wills and other miscellaneous court house records. It appears that the mother of Robert Williams was Stephen's first wife (no marriage found for him in Abbeville County). The name of the wife given in all the later census records is "Nancy E.", not Luticia. Still, this may be the same person because I have seen Nancy used as a nickname for Luticia, Lucretia, Mary, and others. Had they lived until the 1900 census, we could have learned "how many years married" and "number of children" and that information would have clarified the situation.

So, here is young Stephen, with a wife, young child and another female 10-15 years of age. My first conjecture is that this girl is probably an orphaned sister and a daughter of the above Nancy.

In 1832 Stephen returned to purchase more land in Meriwether County. (above). Also, he was married on 12/31/1833 to Luticia Simons (later written Simmons). In 1837, there is a deed which indicates that one, Simon Simmons, has died and that the administrators were Isaac and Mary Simmons. Isaac Williams was found in Pendleton District, S. C. in 1800 having a daughter of the age to be Lutitia. By now, it seems that Meriwether County was his home place because in 1834 he purchased another tract. (All 202-1/2 acres each).

1840 Meriwether County Census - Stephen Williams - male 5-10, 3 female under 5, male 40-50, female 20-30. Apparently the 10-15 year old female listed with him in 1830, did not remove to Georgia. Perhaps she married.

Respecting Lewis Williams who joined Stephen on the first deed. I searched at length to identify this relationship, particularly to learn whether not Lewis was the father. Therefore, I examined the records to identify the generations. While in Meriwether County, I found a Lewis Williams who served in the Confederate Army from Meriwether County in Co. A, enlisted in Anthony Grays on 5/16/1862. Since I did not have the confederate muster rolls, I did not determine more. I do know that there were several Lewis Williams.

Lewis Williams was born 1751, was a Revolutionary War Soldier who resided in Franklin County in 1827 when he drew in the lottery, land in Muscogee County. He was found on the poll tax lists in Franklin County from 1807 to 1829.

Lewis Williams (ca 1800-1855) This Lewis Williams also drew in the 1827 Land Lottery while a resident of DeKalb County, land in Muscogee County. From the book, Columbus, Georgia Newspaper Clippings, from Columbus Enquirer, Vol. VIII, 1853-55, page 262:

"Stewart County. John F. Williams applied in proper form for permanent Letters of Administration For the estate of Lewis Williams late of said county, this is to cite all and singular. The creditors and the next of kin of said deceased. J. L. Wimberly, Ordinary."
2/20/1855

"Died Lewis Williams on 1/13/1855, aged about 55 years. He was a faithful son of Temperance."

John F. Williams, son of above Lewis, was born 1818 in South Carolina according to the 1850 Muscogee County Census. It would appear that the above Lewis Williams was the one listed on the 1840 Stewart County Census.

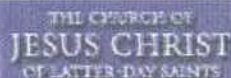

We can now concentrate on the existing Abbeville Co. records.

There is one elemental clue. "The first son was named after the father's father". This clue satisfies why Stephen named his first son "Robert Newton Williams." **I think that Stephen's grandfather was Robert Williams** whose estate was administered on 1/9/1823 in Abbeville County by Joseph and John Williams. (No James Williams was mentioned in this estate, however, there are not enough information to discern any real facts). If this assumption is correct, then Stephen would have been a son of either Joseph or John Williams (above).

"The third son was named after the father". That would be James Williams.

The estate of James Williams was administered 11/23/1836 in Abbeville Co. and did not name Robert. That eliminates James.

That takes us back to Joseph and John, heirs of Robert Williams.

Joseph was on 1820 census but not on the 1830 census. Nancy Williams of the 1830 Census with a son still at home aged 20-30, a match to one of Joseph's sons in 1820 was undoubtedly Joseph's widow.

John Williams Sr. had 2 sons and 3 daughters (in 1820); born ca 1779 and died ca 1839. (no estate found)

John Williams Jr. was born 1800/1810 and had 3 daughters in 1830. His estate was administered 1/12/1843 by Esther Williams. He left 3 infant children (Samuel and John were named as two of them).

John Sr., John Jr., Nancy and Stephen Williams all appeared to be in the same neighborhood in 1830.

This is the exhaustion of all available Abbeville records. However, I think that it is narrowed down to Joseph and John Sr.

I searched for bible records at the Georgia State Archives, the DAR collections, magazine collections and a number of local libraries having bible collections. The only one not searched is the Washington Memorial Library in Macon.

It would be a good idea to order the death certificate of Mary E. Cooper from the State of Georgia. That might provide some additional information, such as an initial or middle name for Stephen or some little nuance. It would also provide

I have searched the census records forward to see if she had any children for possible descendants (to contact). In 1880 there were no children (she was age 30). 1890 Census was destroyed. That would be a critical year to discover children! So far I have not found her on the 1900 or 1910 census. (this will take a lot more time) The 1920 census finds her age 69.

An interesting act exists. Edwin Cooper was born in Buckinghamshire, England and came to America in 1871.

George Wooster was also born in Buckinghamshire, England.

William H. Williams, born 1840, married 2/14/1858 in Meriwether County, Emeline Mote.

Stephen Williams

The 1820 Abbeville County Census is the key to locating the parents of Stephen. He would have been about 12 years old. The candidates are:

John Williams - male under 10, **male 10-16**, male 45 and over, female under 10, female 10-16, female 16-26, female 45 and over.

James Williams - **male 10-16**, male 45 and over, female 16-26.

Joseph Williams, male 26-45, **male 10-16**, 5 female under 10, female 16-26 (gone in 1830)

-- John, James and Joseph born ca 1775--

My conclusion on information discovered thus far. First, I wanted to be certain and eliminate the possibility of Stephen's parents coming to Georgia. As you know, I found a Stephen and Lewis Williams buying up land lotteries in Meriwether County. This Stephen married Lutitia and was found on the 1850 Muscogee County Census, born ca 1800. Lewis Williams, Revolutionary War Soldier, was from Greenville County, S. C. He was a candidate for your Stephen's grandfather. However, he is completely eliminated. Thus having eliminated the early Williams families in Georgia, this leaves only the records in Abbeville Co. (already researched). That is, that Stephen was a son of either John, James or Joseph (above listed). Abbeville's records are lacking in the very deeds and tax digests. Since Stephens occupation (in his latter years) was a "board getter", it may be that the family was poor.

Dear Mr. Williams:

I have been searching Georgia census records to 1910 without any real substitutive results. The reason is there were no absolute matches, viz., names, ages, where born. Normally, I am able to make comparisons between all of the families and identify children, etc. on later records. However, the commonality of these first names and the fact that no record is an exact match in subsequent census records, I am unable to establish real facts. Except for William H. Williams...the information listed below appears to be him. While in the Meriwether County records, I attempted to establish a connection between Stephen and Lewis Williams...at least, eliminate Lewis, but was unable to do so. I also tried to establish that Stephen who married Luticia Simons was a "different Stephen" and was unable to locate another Stephen for that time period, even in the surrounding counties of Muscogee and Troup. The only Stephen Williams who was in Georgia by ca 1835 was your Stephen Williams. Had I located another Stephen Williams in any county in Georgia for that time period, he would have been the "different Stephen". There were no early marriage records kept in South Carolina and wonder where the proof is for your Stephen to have married Ann E. Simpson. The similarity of the surnames could be suspect. The Simons family did reside in Meriwether County and I searched these records but found no one who named a son-in-law, Stephen Williams.

Lewis Williams is the only Georgia clue that we have.

The same problem occurred in Abbeville where no substantial comparisons could be made in the existing records. The Williams families who left records in Abbeville (on the CD) did not link to your Stephen.

Lewis Williams, born 1770/1780, listed on 1840 Muscogee County Census. Female 5-10, female 15-20, female 50-60, male 60-70. This same Lewis was no doubt the one listed on the 1800 Greenville County Census.

Lewis Williams of Meriwether County also had some deed transactions with David and Elijah Williams of North Carolina. The last record of him in Meriwether County was in March Term of 1846 when he was the administrator of Reuben Williams, and gave bond of \$1000. No further information. A search of the Lewis Williams' in S. C. did not disclose a son of Stephen's age.

Thus eliminating the Lewis possibility as a father, still, there is probably some sort of kinship between Lewis and Stephen. Perhaps they were cousins and the old Rev. War Soldier was their grandfather. I could find nothing on the old soldier; he was not listed in the S. C. or GA records as being a soldier, and never applied for a pension. Since Franklin County records were lost, I would be willing to bet that he filed an application in Franklin County if he lived to about 1832.

The 1820 Abbeville Census disclosed 2 possible parents for Stephen.

Joseph Williams male 26-45, son 10-16, 4 females under 10, female 16-26

John Williams male under 10 male 10-16 male 45 and over female under 10 female 10-16 female 16-26, female 45 and over

John was present in 1830. Joseph was gone.

Notice that Joseph had a son 10-16 (fit's Nancy's son 20-30 in 1830); also 4 female under 10. One of these could be residing with Stephen in 1830.

The generation of John and Joseph fit with that of Robert Williams whose estate was administered on 1/9/1823 in Abbeville County by Joseph and John Williams. Robert must have died before 1820, because he was not listed on the census. Stephen Henderson gave a bond of \$700 on 9/1/1823. Notice of an Estate Sale was published in the Providence Church. Purchasers at the sale were: Miss Sarah Williams, Thomas Williams, Stephen Henderson, Elizabeth Williams, John Williams, etc. Inventory by Richard L. Anderson and William Henderson.

Conclusion: Even though the history of the various Williams families in Abbeville County and Meriwether County are similar, the records do not satisfy a proof of parentage. The only thing left is a search of the Abbeville County wills and other miscellaneous court house records. It appears that the mother of Robert Williams was Stephen's first wife (no marriage found for him in Abbeville County). The name of the wife given in all the later census records is "Nancy E.", not Luticia. Still, this may be the same person because I have seen Nancy used as a nickname for Luticia, Lucretia, Mary, and others. Had they lived until the 1900 census, we could have learned "how many years married" and "number of children" and that information would have clarified the situation.

So, here is young Stephen, with a wife, young child and another female 10-15 years of age. My first conjecture is that this girl is probably an orphaned sister and a daughter of the above Nancy.

In 1832 Stephen returned to purchase more land in Meriwether County. (above). Also, he was married on 12/31/1833 to Luticia Simons (later written Simmons). In 1837, there is a deed which indicates that one, Simon Simmons, has died and that the administrators were Isaac and Mary Simmons. Isaac Williams was found in Pendleton District, S. C. in 1800 having a daughter of the age to be Lutitia. By now, it seems that Meriwether County was his home place because in 1834 he purchased another tract. (All 202-1/2 acres each).

Lewis Williams was born 1751, was a Revolutionary War Soldier who resided in Franklin County in 1827 when he drew in the lottery, land in Muscogee County. He was found on the poll tax lists in Franklin County from 1807 to 1829.

I have just concluded Georgia records of Meriwether, Stewart, Troup and Franklin Counties as well as Abbeville County, South Carolina records, except the deeds, which I do not have access to here in Atlanta.

My first objective to make certain that Stephen Williams did or did not come to Georgia with his parents. As you will read in the outline below, I think that you will agree that he was the first of his immediately family to venture to Meriwether County.

I personally travelled to Meriwether County and examined all possible records. As you will see from the enclosed deed records, Stephen Williams was speculating on land by buying up the land lotteries awarded in 1827. The first acquisition was Lot 156 in the 8th district which he and Lewis Williams purchased from Isaac Hamby on 2/20/1828 for \$300.00. On 2/27/1828 Stephen and Lewis purchased Lot 136 in the 10th district. Since his first born (Robert) was born in Abbeville County in 1829, he apparently returned home after the first acquisition. He was back in Meriwether County in 1830, this time selling on 1/8th to Pleasant Cox, Lot 47 in the 8th district. (In 1832 he purchased this same lot from Samuel Swilly). On 9/7th of 1830 he purchased land at a Sheriff's Sale in the 11th district, Lot 42.

Stephen must have been back in Abbeville by the summer because he was enumerated on the 1830 Abbeville County Census as follows -

Lewis Williams, born 1770/1780, listed on 1840 Muscogee County Census. Female 5-10, female 15-20, female 50-60, male 60-70. This same Lewis was no doubt the one listed on the 1800 Greenville County Census.

Lewis Williams of Meriwether County also had some deed transactions with David and Elijah Williams of North Carolina. The last record of him in Meriwether County was in March Term of 1846 when he was the administrator of Reuben Williams, and gave bond of \$1000. No further information. A search of the Lewis Williams' in S. C. did not disclose a son of Stephen's age.

Thus eliminating the Lewis possibility as a father, still, there is probably some sort of kinship between Lewis and Stephen. Perhaps they were cousins and the old Rev. War Soldier was their grandfather. I could find nothing on the old soldier; he was not listed in the S. C. or GA records as being a soldier, and never applied for a pension. Since Franklin County records were lost, I would be willing to bet that he filed an application in Franklin County if he lived to about 1832.

The 1820 Abbeville Census disclosed 2 possible parents for Stephen.

Joseph Williams male 26-45, son 10-16, 4 females under 10, female 16-26

John Williams male under 10 male 10-16 male 45 and over female under 10 female 10-16 female 16-26, female 45 and over

John was present in 1830. Joseph was gone.

Notice that Joseph had a son 10-16 (fit's Nancy's son 20-30 in 1830); also 4 female under 10. One of these could be residing with Stephen in 1830.

The generation of John and Joseph fit with that of Robert Williams whose estate was administered on 1/9/1823 in Abbeville County by Joseph and John Williams. Robert must have died before 1820, because he was not listed on the census. Stephen Henderson gave a bond of \$700 on 9/1/1823. Notice of an Estate Sale was published in the Providence Church. Purchasers at the sale were: Miss Sarah Williams, Thomas Williams, Stephen Henderson, Elizabeth Williams, John Williams, etc. Inventory by Richard L. Anderson and William Henderson.

Conclusion: Even though the history of the various Williams families in Abbeville County and Meriwether County are similar, the records do not satisfy a proof of parentage. The only thing left is a search of the Abbeville County wills and other miscellaneous court house records. It appears that the mother of Robert Williams was Stephen's first wife (no marriage found for him in Abbeville County). The name of the wife given in all the later census records is "Nancy E.", not Luticia. Still, this may be the same person because I have seen Nancy used as a nickname for Luticia, Lucretia, Mary, and others. We can now concentrate on the existing Abbeville Co. records.

There is one elemental clue. "The first son was named after the father's father". This clue satisfies why Stephen named his first son "Robert Newton Williams." **I think that Stephen's grandfather was Robert Williams** whose estate was administered on 1/9/1823 in Abbeville County by Joseph and John Williams. (No James Williams was mentioned in this estate, however, there are not enough information to discern any real facts). If this assumption is correct, then Stephen would have been a son of either Joseph or John Williams (above).

"The third son was named after the father". That would be James Williams.

The estate of James Williams was administered 11/23/1836 in Abbeville Co. and did not name Robert. That eliminates James.

That takes us back to Joseph and John, heirs of Robert Williams.

Joseph was on 1820 census but not on the 1830 census. Nancy Williams of the 1830 Census with a son still at home aged 20-30, a match to one of Joseph's sons in 1820 was undoubtedly Joseph's widow.

John Williams Sr. had 2 sons and 3 daughters (in 1820); born ca 1779 and died ca 1839. (no estate found)

John Williams Jr. was born 1800/1810 and had 3 daughters in 1830. His estate was administered 1/12/1843 by Esther Williams. He left 3 infant children (Samuel and John were named as two of them).

John Sr., John Jr., Nancy and Stephen Williams all appeared to be in the same neighborhood in 1830.

This is the exhaustion of all available Abbeville records. However, I think that it is narrowed down to Joseph and John Sr.

I searched for bible records at the Georgia State Archives, the DAR collections, magazine collections and a number of local libraries having bible collections. The only one not searched is the Washington Memorial Library in Macon.

It would be a good idea to order the death certificate of Mary E. Cooper from the State of Georgia. That might provide some additional information, such as an initial or middle name for Stephen or some little nuance. It would also provide

I have searched the census records forward to see if she had any children for possible descendants (to contact). In 1880 there were no children (she was age 30). 1890 Census was destroyed. That would be a critical year to discover children! So far I have not found her on the 1900 or 1910 census. (this will take a lot more time) The 1920 census finds her age 69.

An interesting act exists. Edwin Cooper was born in Buckinghamshire, England and came to America in 1871.

George Wooster was also born in Buckinghamshire, England.

William H. Williams, born 1840, married 2/14/1858 in Meriwether County, Emeline Mote.

Stephen Williams

The 1820 Abbeville County Census is the key to locating the parents of Stephen. He would have been about 12 years old. The candidates are:

John Williams - male under 10, **male 10-16**, male 45 and over, female under 10, female 10-16, female 16-26, female 45 and over.

James Williams - **male 10-16**, male 45 and over, female 16-26.

Joseph Williams, male 26-45, **male 10-16**, 5 female under 10, female 16-26 (gone in 1830)

-- John, James and Joseph born ca 1775--

My conclusion on information discovered thus far. First, I wanted to be certain and eliminate the possibility of Stephen's parents coming to Georgia. As you know, I found a Stephen and Lewis Williams buying up land lotteries in Meriwether County. This Stephen married Lutitia and was found on the 1850 Muscogee County Census, born ca 1800. Lewis Williams, Revolutionary War Soldier, was from Greenville County, S. C. He was a candidate for your Stephen's grandfather. However, he is completely eliminated. Thus having eliminated the early Williams families in Georgia, this leaves only the records in Abbeville Co. (already researched). That is, that Stephen was a son of either John, James or Joseph (above listed). Abbeville's records are lacking in the very deeds and tax digests. Since Stephens occupation (in his latter years) was a "board getter", it may be that the family was poor.

Dear Mr. Williams:

I have been searching Georgia census records to 1910 without any real substitutive results. The reason is there were no absolute matches, viz., names, ages, where born. Normally, I am able to make comparisons between all of the families and identify children, etc. on later records. However, the commonality of these first names and the fact that no record is an exact match in subsequent census records, I am unable to establish real facts. Except for William H. Williams...the information listed below appears to be him. While in the Meriwether County records, I attempted to establish a connection between Stephen and Lewis Williams...at least, eliminate Lewis, but was unable to do so. I also tried to establish that Stephen who married Luticia Simons was a "different Stephen" and was unable to locate another Stephen for that time period, even in the surrounding counties of Muscogee and Troup. The only Stephen Williams who was in Georgia by ca 1835 was your Stephen Williams. Had I located another Stephen Williams in any county in Georgia for that time period, he would have been the "different Stephen". There were no early marriage records kept in South Carolina and wonder where the proof is for your Stephen to have married Ann E. Simpson. The similarity of the surnames could be suspect. The Simons family did reside in Meriwether County and I searched these records but found no one who named a son-in-law, Stephen Williams.

Lewis Williams is the only Georgia clue that we have.

The same problem occurred in Abbeville where no substantial comparisons could be made in the existing records. The Williams families who left records in Abbeville (on the CD) did not link to your Stephen.

Lewis Williams, born 1770/1780, listed on 1840 Muscogee County Census. Female 5-10, female 15-20, female 50-60, male 60-70. This same Lewis was no doubt the one listed on the 1800 Greenville County Census.

Lewis Williams of Meriwether County also had some deed transactions with David and Elijah Williams of North Carolina. The last record of him in Meriwether County was in March Term of 1846 when he was the administrator of Reuben Williams, and gave bond of \$1000. No further information. A search of the Lewis Williams' in S. C. did not disclose a son of Stephen's age.

Thus eliminating the Lewis possibility as a father, still, there is probably some sort of kinship between Lewis and Stephen. Perhaps they were cousins and the old Rev. War Soldier was their grandfather. I could find nothing on the old soldier; he was not listed in the S. C. or GA records as being a soldier, and never applied for a pension. Since Franklin County records were lost, I would be willing to bet that he filed an application in Franklin County if he lived to about 1832.

The 1820 Abbeville Census disclosed 2 possible parents for Stephen.

Joseph Williams male 26-45, son 10-16, 4 females under 10, female 16-26

John Williams male under 10 male 10-16 male 45 and over female under 10 female 10-16 female 16-26, female 45 and over

John was present in 1830. Joseph was gone.

Notice that Joseph had a son 10-16 (fit's Nancy's son 20-30 in 1830); also 4 female under 10. One of these could be residing with Stephen in 1830.

The generation of John and Joseph fit with that of Robert Williams whose estate was administered on 1/9/1823 in Abbeville County by Joseph and John Williams. Robert must have died before 1820, because he was not listed on the census. Stephen Henderson gave a bond of \$700 on 9/1/1823. Notice of an Estate Sale was published in the Providence Church. Purchasers at the sale were: Miss Sarah Williams, Thomas Williams, Stephen Henderson, Elizabeth Williams, John Williams, etc. Inventory by Richard L. Anderson and William Henderson.

Conclusion: Even though the history of the various Williams families in Abbeville County and Meriwether County are similar, the records do not satisfy a proof of parentage. The only thing left is a search of the Abbeville County wills and other miscellaneous court house records. It appears that the mother of Robert Williams was Stephen's first wife (no marriage found for him in Abbeville County). The name of the wife given in all the later census records is "Nancy E.", not Luticia. Still, this may be the same person because I have seen Nancy used as a nickname for Luticia, Lucretia, Mary, and others. Had they lived until the 1900 census, we could have learned "how many years married" and "number of children" and that information would have clarified the situation.

So, here is young Stephen, with a wife, young child and another female 10-15 years of age. My first conjecture is that this girl is probably an orphaned sister and a daughter of the above Nancy.

In 1832 Stephen returned to purchase more land in Meriwether County. (above). Also, he was married on 12/31/1833 to Luticia Simons (later written Simmons). In 1837, there is a deed which indicates that one, Simon Simmons, has died and that the administrators were Isaac and Mary Simmons. Isaac Williams was found in Pendleton District, S. C. in 1800 having a daughter of the age to be Lutitia. By now, it seems that Meriwether County was his home place because in 1834 he purchased another tract. (All 202-1/2 acres each).

1840 Meriwether County Census – Stephen Williams – male 5-10, 3 female under 5, male 40-50, female 20-30. Apparently the 10-15 year old female listed with him in 1830, did not remove to Georgia. Perhaps she married.

Respecting Lewis Williams who joined Stephen on the first deed. I searched at length to identify this relationship, particularly to learn whether not Lewis was the father. Therefore, I examined the records to identify the generations. While in Meriwether County, I found a Lewis Williams who served in the Confederate Army from Meriwether County in Co. A, enlisted in Anthony Grays on 5/16/1862. Since I did not have the confederate muster rolls, I did not determine more. I do know that there were several Lewis Williams.

Lewis Williams was born 1751, was a Revolutionary War Soldier who resided in Franklin County in 1827 when he drew in the lottery, land in Muscogee County. He was found on the poll tax lists in Franklin County from 1807 to 1829.

Lewis Williams (ca 1800-1855) This Lewis Williams also drew in the 1827 Land Lottery while a resident of DeKalb County, land in Muscogee County. From the book, Columbus, Georgia Newspaper Clippings, from Columbus Enquirer, Vol. VIII, 1853-55, page 262:

“Stewart County. John F. Williams applied in proper form for permanent Letters of Administration For the estate of Lewis Williams late of said county, this is to cite all and singular. The creditors and the next of kin of said deceased. J. L. Wimberly, Ordinary.”
2/20/1855

“Died Lewis Williams on 1/13/1855, aged about 55 years. He was a faithful son of Temperance.”

John F. Williams, son of above Lewis, was born 1818 in South Carolina according to the 1850 Muscogee County Census. It would appear that the above Lewis Williams was the one listed on the 1840 Stewart County Census.
