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PREFACE.

The earliest Register now preserved in the Parish contains Marriages 1755—1836; another volume containing Baptisms and Burials begins in 1764. The earlier entries here given have been extracted from the Bishop's Transcripts at Hereford. It will be noticed that for a few years no returns have been found, owing, in some instances, to their having been either lost or mislaid, and in others, perhaps, to there having been no return to make. The only family in the position of gentry resident in the parish during the period over which these Registers extend was that of Monington, which, as well as a considerable number of the other residents in the parish, belonged to the Roman Catholic religion. There is, therefore, a notable absence of baptisms and marriages of those who professed that faith. Their burials, which were unavoidable, appear; and in several instances it will be noticed that their births are entered in lieu of baptism. All the inscriptions in the church and churchyard, and some notices of the Sarnesfields, and of the Moningtons who owned the parish till recent times, will be found in *The Genealogist*, New Series, vol. xii., pp. 7-18.

The House was finish'd in the Year 1801.

The Rev^d J^s Bull deposited two hundred & ten Pounds in the Hands of J. W. Weston who never allowed a Farthing Interest which Sum J. W. Weston accepted agreeably to the Exchange of Lands between them, & J. W. Weston promised to complete the Out-buildings at his own expence which He never perform'd & as the Plan of the House was too small for a Clergyman there being no Cellar, nor Garrets mention'd, the Plan was obliged to be enlarged, & M^r Weston did not allow any Thing towards it, so that the wholes was paid by Mee D. P. Powell, Rector.

The Sum total was £284 19 9 for the Building of the House. M^r Weston did not allow anything towards the Premises so that the Expence fell very heavy on Me D. P. Powell every thing about the House and Place being very ruinous. Captain Davies executor to M^r Bull allowed £15 17 6 & declared he would have allow'd £100 more but he thought M^r Weston being a gentleman, would never have attempted to throw the Expence upon the Clergyman as every thing was done according to his Desire in the above Exchange of Lands w^{ch} was more in Favor of M^r Weston than the Rector, the old Glebe being better Land than the present.

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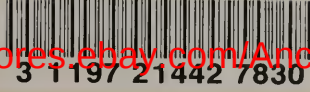
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
