


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

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## PREFACE.

THE Registers of Scorbrough date from 1653, on the outside of the first book appears :—

No. 1. The register booke  
for Scorbrough  
1653

It is 12 in. by 7 in. in size, and consists of 32 parchment leaves, one or two leaves have been cut out and the lower half of the first page is gone. Outside the parchment pages are four paper sheets scribbled with the names of Richard Stork, John Stork, Robert Stork, and Geo: Wight, 1736. The book is bound in thick limp parchment, and is in fair condition.

On the outside of the second book is :—

Scorbrough Register.  
1784.

In size it is  $10\frac{3}{4}$  in. by  $6\frac{3}{4}$  in., and is bound in stiff parchment cover. The first leaf is paper and the remainder of the book consists of 8 parchment pages, four leaves have been removed. This is also in fair condition but shows signs of having at some time experienced damp.
