

Humphrey/Humphries of Jackson County

Uriah Humphries was born 1704 in Botetourt County, Virginia, married Nancy Statham. Issue: Leddy Humphries, Julia Humphries, Joseph Humphries (1745-1811), Julian Humphries, Polly Humphries, Mariah Humphries, Patsy Humphries, Elijah Humphries, Presley Thornton Humphries, and Mattison Tigner Humphries.

There is a Joseph Humphrey (1745-1811) who married Rebecca Phelps. They lived in Franklin County. His LWT was produced in the Jackson Court Ordinary by the oaths of Job Rogers and George Hampton on 7 January 1811.

Jackson County Deeds

Deed Book A, page 254-255, 13 March 1798. William Berry and Susannah Berry, his wife, of Oglethorpe County deeded to Joseph Humphries of Jackson County for \$200, 149 acres in Jackson County.

Book D, page 374. Joseph Humphries deeded to Thomas Willingham, both of Jackson County, for \$300.00, 100 acres Jackson County located on both sides of the north fork of the Oconee River, bounded by John Callehan, Thomas Hughy and Humphries, it being part of a 960 acre grant to Daniel W. Easley on 19 February 1789 and conveyed by Andrew Miller to Joseph Humphries on 27 June 1805.

John Humphries was born ca 1690 in Surry County, Virginia and died 1738 in St. Andrews Parish, Brunswick County, Virginia, the son of Robert Humphrey and his wife, Mary. He married Mary White, and had issue:

G. Richard Humphries, born ca 1763, died 1820 in Chester District, South Carolina. He was a Major in the

War of 1812. Later removed to Franklin County, Georgia, where he died. From *Memoirs of Georgia*, Vol. I:
"Leaving South Carolina, he came to Georgia and settled in Franklin County, where he continued farming

1. G. W. Humphries was born in Chester District, South Carolina, and removed to Franklin, Morgan and DeKalb Counties, Georgia. He later removed to Calhoun County, Alabama, where he died in 1890. He married Zul McIntyre, the daughter of John Gunter McIntyre, a native of Scotland. He served as a magistrate in Morgan County for several years and represented the legislature for one term. Issue:

a. John R. Humphries, physician and surgeon, was born on 13 October 1833. He graduated from the University of Georgia at August in 1856, and first located in DeKalb County, later serving as a Confederate in 1861, removing in 1862 to Acworth, in Cobb County. He married (1) in 1859 Sarah Joyce (born 1842 in DeKalb County), the daughter of Robert Joyce, a native of North Carolina, and by her had one daughter, Eugalene Humphries. Sarah died in 1861. After Sarah's death, he married in 1882, (2) Miss Octavia H. Strickland (born in Forsyth County), a daughter of Colonel Hardy Strickland. They had one child: John R. Humphries, Jr., born 28 Mar 1883.
