

Hutcheson of Clayton County

Furney Hutcheson was born 4/11/1784 in South Carolina and died 10/1865 in Clayton County, Georgia, buried in the Hutcheson Cemetery. Issue:

- Roland Hutcheson, born 11/22/1810 in South Carolina, died 4/19/1856 in Jonesboro, buried in the Hutcheson Cemetery.
- Leander Carruth Hutcheson, born 6/19/1820 in Blount County, Tennessee, died 6/16/1903 in Jonesboro, Clayton County, buried in Hutcheson cemetery. He built the historical Hutcheson Home located on College Street in Jonesboro. He was married in 1860 to Julia Sims, born 9/26/1841 in Meriwether County, died 8/22/1916 in Jonesboro. Issue:



This 2-story brick home is part of the Historical District of Jonesboro. It was built ca 1880

for Leander Carruth Hutcheson, a prominent citizen and sheriff of Clayton County. It



features a central hall and crosshall with two story galleries on two sides of the house. The front and side entrances on both floors feature rectangular window lights and interior doors with four paned transom lights. The roof has several gables with ornate iron grillwork in the air vents. The bulustrades and posts on the galleries are Victorian in design. The main building is a four room cube on each floor. It is now owned by the First Baptist Church.
