between the Children of allst Mary Lodge
Widow, and My Sister Hester, and the Children
of My Three Brothers, Backus, Zebulon
and Nathaniel, to Each of the aforesaid
Children an Equal proportion, — and
I likewise Constitute make and ordain
and appoint My Trusty Friends the Hon^{ble}
of J^{ms} Mary Executor of this My last will
and Testament, and Burwell Toltrop, the
other Executor, and My beloved wife Rachel
Executor of this My last will & Testament, —

And I do hereby utterly disallow, revoke
and annul, all and every other former
Testaments and Wills, Legacies, bequests and
Executors, by me in anywise made, written
and bequeathed, ratified and Confirming
this and no other to be my last will and
Testament, In Witness Whereof I
