Executors hereafter named and that my debts
beginning a Christian burial and that a
suitable grave stone be set for my son
I am second

The next and Residue of my Estate I devise
and bequeath unto my beloved Mother
Elizabeth and Children if living at my
death share and share alike
however if only one of of my named
Mother survives me then the share that
would have gone to such deceased Mother
if living at my death I devise and bequeath
unto such deceased Mother wife if she
survives me but if she does not survive
me then I devise and bequeath such
share of my Estate to such deceased Mother's
Children share and share alike the Children
of such deceased Child taking their
Parents part

Further second I survive both of my named
Mother and the wife of each of my said
Mother named I living at the my death
then I devise my Estate Estate to such
survive share and share alike but if I
survive only one of such wives then the
surviving wife is hereby devised one
half of my Estate and the other half is

devoted unto the Children of my deceased
Mother whose wife is deceased at the time of
my death
but in the event I survive each of the wives
then in that event I devise my said Estate
unto the Children of my said wife Elizabeth
who shall take the same per stirpes and not per
capite the Children of such deceased Children
taking their Parents share
I am third

I hereby constitute and appoint my beloved
friend and Cousin Dr. Samuel Robinson
now residing of Camden County Executor of the
my last Will and Testament and Receiver of the
same making him executor and Receiver of
my Estate of making return of appraisement
of my Estate or any other business and I
authorize him to execute my Executor full
power and authority to sell at public or
private sale without order from the Court of
Georgia or any other Court or Tribunal
any and all debts of my said property that may
be necessary for the payment of said debts
or all or any of grave stones and Costs of
administration and distribution of residue
to those entitled to same under the provision
of this my Will
