Graham of the County of Camden State of  
Georgia Widow being in a low state of  
Health of Body but of Perfect Sound  
Mind and Memory calling to mind the  
Mortality of my body knowing that it is  
Appointed for all men to die we constitute  
and ordain this my last will and Testament  
that is to say - First of all I commend  
my Soul to Almightie God who gave it and  
my body to the dust to be decently Buried  
at the direction of my Executors herein after  
named Trusting in the Merits of Jesus  
Christ for a Glorious Resurrection at the  
Last day And Touching such worldly  
Estate as it hath pleased God to bless me  
with, I bequeath and devise in the  
following Manner To wit I give to my  
Loving Son Archibald Graham a Negro  
Woman named Phoebe Provided he shall  
Take care of my Son John and Daughter Mary  
untill they are sixteen Years Old by letting  
them have use of the said Negro Phoebe

during the above time so as to prevent them  
from incurring any unnecessary Expence & loss  
so as to diminish their own part of the  
property - Secondly I give to my Loving  
Son Colin Graham a Negro Man named  
Sam on the same Condition as the other first  
mentioned to assist in raising my Brother John  
and Sister Mary full from Expence so as to  
diminish their own part of the property untill  
they are sixteen Years Old, Thirdly, I Give  
unto my Son Graham of Negro Woman  
named, Oler... Fourthly give and devise  
unto my Son Thos. G. Archibald Colin  
and John upon Condition that they pay to  
my Daughter Mary one hundred and forty  
Dollars as her proportionable part of her  
Yatch or estate the plantation and tract of  
Land where I now reside, this sum I wish  
to be raised out of the Labour of the hands  
that I now bequeath and the plantations  
use - Fifthly give and devise to my daugh-  
ter Mary my one third of all the Land  
that belongs to me and which I  
am entitled to

Inventory, all the remaining part of my  
Property, Consisting of Cattle, Hogs, Horses, Tools,  
Furniture and Lard, I give and bequeath  
to my four Children above mentioned to be  
Equally Divided amongst them by right two  
+ Coler I give to my daughter Anna Jane  
and two Cows and Coler which I give to my  
daughter Rachel, each to be taken out of  
the Stock before any service they place -  
Lastly I nominate Constables & appoint  
my Loving and useful Son Archibald  
Graham, and my worthy & trusty Friends  
Charles McCallum Junr. Executors to this my  
Last will and Testament.

In Testimony whereof I the said  
John Graham have hereunto set my hand  
and Seal to this my Last will and Testament  
this twenty seventh day of July 1807.

Camden Will Book A

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A memorandum of Saml Crozier Will  
Made Verbally before Doctor Ezekiah Stone  
Samuel Boyd, and Timothy Hopkins,  
Called as Witnesses, on the 27<sup>th</sup> October 1808  
and the said Samuel Crozier said in  
presence of the aforesaid three witnesses that  
he wished all his property to be Equally  
divided between his two Sisters Mary and  
Elizabeth, the above done on the said Crozier  
death Bed in the Town of Jefferson, Georgia Land  
County.  
Sworn to before me this tenth day  
of November 1808.

Personally appeared before me Mary Ann  
Muzzell one of the subscribing Witnesses to the  
annexed Last will & Testament of Ann  
Graham who being duly sworn says that  
she saw the said Ann Graham make  
her mark to the s<sup>d</sup> Will, and that she  
also saw Abraham Bepent and James  
Ellis, two other subscribing Witnesses sign  
their names therunto.
