

Alexander Ogden's Will

In the name of God amen I Alexander Ogden being in a Low State of Health But of Sound mind and memory knowing that it is appointed unto all men to Die Do make this my last Will and testament in manner and form as follows I Give and bequeath to my dear Son Darius Couch a Lot of Land in the City of Augusta Whereon at present Lives Hephzibah Ogden and Elizabeth (Robertson) With all the Buildings and appurtenances thereunto Belonging one fourth part of the above Lot to be given to Elizabeth Robertson's oldest Child provided She has one and if She never has a Child then it is to Remain and Belong to Darius Couch Also I Give unto the said Darius Couch a Note of Hand on Randolph's Bill Drawing for two hundred and fifty three dollars twenty five Cents Also whatever may be adjudged to me for my Services with King and Bailey on Speculation plantations in Justin's Bay Whose I have accounts for my Land and that this 27th of September 1819
