

Last Will of Mrs Anita M. Rightmire

St Marys Ga October 28th 1897.
 In the Name of God I Anita M. Rightmire
 being of sound and disposing mind, and trusting
 in God for peace beyond the grave, and trusting
 last Will and Testament, that whatever real
 Estate or landed property, situated in the State of
 Georgia, Florida, or any other part of the World,
 with all and every improvement thereon, and of
 which I do hold the legal Vests for the same,
 also all household effects, Cattle, Stocks of any kind
 Money Goods or worldly possessions, Gold or Silver
 that I am possessed, to go to the Child of my
 Adoption, "Mari, Viola Rightmire" and her Children
 should she marry, die and leave such, whatever
 I may be possessed of is left to Mari, to use as
 she likes best. In her own personal benefit, or
 for her own Children, that is whatever property
 remains, after my just and legal debts are paid
 therefrom, Exceptional, My Watch and Chain
 Table Silver Ware, and Jewelry, All such ex-
 ceptively, I particularly wish for Mari to have
 after my death, To Eddie I Rightmire, alias Mr
 C. Edward Douglas, to him I bequeath the Value
 of One Dollars worth in a Book, VIZ One Catholic
 Family Bible. Once the property of Eddie I
 Rightmires good kind foster "papa" Isaac
 Samuel Rightmire. I hope he will study it
 well and learn the lesson it teaches of the
 "Golden Rule" "Do unto others as you would
 they should do unto you." Conditions VIZ
 should I be forced through indigent circumstances
 to seek a home of Charity, in the Kingdom of the
 Widows Home and die therein, after being
 cared for there, under such Condition then

Whatever I die possessed of is to be equally divided, between the "Widows Home" and Mari, with the Exception of such thing as I particularly and exclusively named. Marked, Bonded, and noted with a hand note, is to be given to Mari V. Rightmire and her children. Given the right, as afore said named, to Mari for her personal benefit, and after to her children, should she die leaving children. (Should Mari die leaving no children, in that case, let all any every thing I die possessed of go to the "Widows Home" in Savannah Ga. "My Gold Spectacle" are to be given to the Widows Home; that is if I should die an inmate of their Asylum. Otherwise they are to belong to Mari, with every thing else excepting the "Holy Bible" that I have made mention of. Should John R. Bucklew survive me I wish him my Executor in the case of this Will, and see that justice is done to the parties I have named; should of John R. Bucklew be not alive, in that case, let some other just and reliable person, (Outside of my relatives) act in his place.

Signed sealed and delivered the 28th day of October A.D. 1897, at St Mary Ga. Camden County.
