this my last Will and Testament
revoking all others by me heretofore
made,

Item First

I desire that my body be bur-
ied in a decent and Christianlike
Manner suitable to my Circumstances
in life, and my soul I trust shall
return to rest with God who gave it,
through the Merits of Our Blessed Lord
Jesus Christ.

Item, Second.

I desire that all my just
debts be paid, without delay, or as
soon as possible after my death.

Item, Third.

I give bequeath and devise to my
wife "Margaret," for and during her
natural life all the Land now under
graze lying to the East of the Public
Road, leading from Jefferson to
St Marys, that is, to say the enclosed
lot on which I now live, excepting

any part of the same which may
take in any part of the land owned
by William H. Tomlin. She to have during
life the use of all buildings on the same
and the absolute use of all rents issues
and profits of said Lot for her sole
use. And the Lot mentioned in this Item
as devised to my wife, Margaret, during
her natural life, at her death I give
and bequeath to my youngest son, Sam,
my free simple sole and

Item Fourth.

The Balance of my land or any other
property, I give bequeath and devise
to my wife, Margaret, my Daughter
"Julia," my Son Robert, my Son Joseph,
my Daughter "Lena," my Daughter "Mary"
and my Son Sam, share and share
alike. And it is my desire, and I do
so direct that, any debt that I may owe
shall be paid out of the property mentioned
in this Item.

Item Fifth.

I hereby appoint my Daughter
Julia Thomas, Executrix of this my last
Will and Testament.
