First and principally I resign my

the hands of the Almighty God my
Creator humbly hoping for a blessed
immortality thro the merits and medi-
ation of my blessed Saviour and
Redeemer Jesus Christ And my body
I desire may be decently buried at the

of my Executors Thomas &
and Brittain R. Dumbly both of this
and County aforesaid and for each
Impart & also the share in his great
goodness and money hath entrusted me
to his Stewart if I give down and
dispose thereof I as follows
I give and bequeath to my worthy daughter
Mary Harris and the heirs of her
body the one half of the land called
Bear Hammock also a Negro boy
named Rome I give and bequeath to
my worthy son Thomas P. Dumbly
the remaining half of the land called
Bear Hammock and a Negro man
named Joe also a Negro woman
named Katy I give and bequeath to
my worthy son Brittain R. Dumbly
and his heirs forever Five Bolls of
Wheat and the appurtenances thereunto
belonging also the Stock of Cattle two
one Hog House Lard and Kitchens furni-
ture and all machines and plantation
requisites of all sorts likewise three
negroes John Dick and Charlotte
with her increase
I give and bequeath to my worthy
daughter Sarah Clark four the heirs
of her body Four Hundred dollars
hard cash money to be paid by my Executors
Thomas P. Dumbly and Brittain R.
Dumbly each to pay one hundred

The said last named legacy to be paid
one year after my death
I do hereby appoint my worthy sons
Thomas P. Dumbly and Brittain R.
Dumbly Executors to this my last Will
and Testaments hereby revoking all
other Wills heretofore made by me
Given under my hand and seal this
10 day of March A.D. 1821
