

Basile Pelletier's Will

State of Georgia Town of St Marys
Camden Will Book A November 22nd 1822

I Basile Pelletier a native of Picardie
in France being of Sound Mind and Memory
but in a low state of health make known
and publish this to be my last will and
testament annulling all former ones by
me heretofore made.

First my will and desire is that my body be
decently interred in the Catholic Order
or at the discretion of Executors
I am. That all my just debts be paid agreea-
ble to the rules and Order of Law.

Third my will and desire is that all the balance
of my estate and Effects shall be
paid over to my beloved Son.

Espere de Force Pelletier as my Sole heir
to be remitted to my said Son by my
Executor in such way as he may consider
best for the benefit of said heir.

Fourthly I appoint my said Son Friend Louis
Du four my Sole executor to this my
last will and testament.
