

Will and Testament of Caroline Lang

State of Georgia } I Caroline Lang of Camden County -
 Camden Co. } Georgia do make this my last will
 and Testament. To Wit - First I desire
 that all of my just debts be paid
 Second, I give and bequeath all of my property
 of any and every description to my Son, Alexander
 Lang, in trust, to have and hold the same in
 his name for the use and benefit of my beloved
 daughter Angelina Lang, and my Son Nathan
 Lang, share and share alike. If my
 daughter should ever marry, and desire
 a distribution, or desire the same for any
 other reasonable purpose, then the said Alexander
 Lang as Trustee, shall call in two or three other
 discreet and honorable men, and make as
 far as possible an equal distribution of
 every thing to be the said Alexander Lang to
 still hold the share awarded to her in trust
 only for her and her children, as well as the
 other share in trust for my Son Nathan Lang.

In bequeathing my property herein set forth,
 I mean and include every species or class
 of property I may die possessed of without
 any reservation whatever. And further wish
 my friends and kindred one and all to know
 and believe that I do this from the best of
 motives, and the kindest of feelings towards them
 all.

I desire further that no legal
 expenses be brought on my estate
 further than admitting this instrument to Record
