ing disposed to make a disposition of such prop-
erty as I may have at the time of my decease do make
this my Testament Last Will as follows - I give devise
and bequeath all my Estate and property real personal
mixed mixed to Jane M. Sterling and her two chil-
dren and Thomas their Heirs Executors, admin-
istrators assigns to be divided between them in equal
proportion as tenants in common and in case either
of them should die before the age of eighteen -

and unmarried then I give devise and bequeath this
property to the survivors in the same manner. I
do hereby constitute and appoint Edward Wigman of S.
Marys George John Frederick Clarke and Fran-
cis Richard the younger Executors of this my last
Testament and last Will. In witness whereof I
have hereunto set my hand and seal this twen-
ty second day of March A.D. One Thousand
Eight hundred & ~~thirty~~ ^{thirty}.
