I Last will and Testament
of Dolly King & Dolly King being of sound and
disposing mind and memory do make this my
last will and Testament hereby revoking all
wills heretofore made by me Revoking clause is
Common but superfluous

Item 1 I wish my Executor as soon as possible after
my death to pay my debts If a sale be
of Property shall be necessary I wish him to
select for sale that which can be sold most
advantageously used for that purpose and
I authorize him to sell the same at Public
or private sale as he may see fit

Item 2 and I give to my beloved Children
8 named as follows Will King David
King and Lizzie Robinson Marya Jones
Anney King Olive King Fannie King five
Kids the following property to wit
to be Equally divided between the 8 heirs
my land and home at Granville in Camden
County Said State

Item 3 and one horse and Cart & buggy and
Wagon Sugar Cane Mill and boiler and
all the Cows and Calf and Oxen and
my place at Spring Hill in the County Cam
Said State with the goat & sheep

Item 4 I do hereby appoint Josiah Gibbs
Executor of this my Will (&) and as
extra Compensation for his services over
and above Commission give him the
sum of \$600 to be taken from the
Residuary funds and to be paid when of I have
been dead my heirs this 15th day of April 1912
