

Will of George W. Benson

Camden Will Bk C1
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In the name of God Amen, I, George W. Benson of the City of Marietta, County of Cobb, in the State of Georgia, being of sound mind, Declare, Make and Publish this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all Wills by me heretofore made, I appoint and constitute my Wife Mary, A. Benson, my sole Executrix to manage and control my property at her will, judgment and discretion free from control of the Courts of Ordinary or Surrogate, and shall not be required to make returns or reports to any such Courts, of any acts or doings hereunder nor shall my Executrix be required to give bonds hereunder,
My just debts and funeral expenses must be paid without unnecessary delay,
I give, devise and bequeath all property real, personal or mixed of whatever nature and wherever located, of which I die possessed, to my said Wife, Mary, A. Benson, during her life time, and thereafter such as shall remain thereof to our Children, But, and in the event of her death and the decease of all our Children, without having left issue, then all such remaining property and product thereof shall go to and become the property of my Brother Arthur Benson, his heirs, Executors, Administrators and assigns forever.
