age of Twenty one and in case he should not
live to arrive to the before mentioned age
then said property to be divided between my
daughters Maria and Louisa when the same shall

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Shall arrive to the age of ^{eighteen} years
before the said division shall take place it is
my wish and desire that my beloved wife
Mary to reserve for herself during her life time
one third part of all my property for her
maintenance

It is also my will and desire that all of
my Children above named be supported and
educated from the income of my property and
in case the said income should not prove
sufficient for the same that my Executors
dispose of as much property for their support
and education as might be deemed necessary
and I do hereby make nominate
constitute and appoint my beloved wife Mary
sole executrix of this my last will and Testament
hereby revoking and making void all and
every other will and wills at any time here-
fore by me made and do declare this
to be my last will and Testament
